Driver of unit #1 was very confused and possibly has suffered some kind of medical emergency. She was transported to FVSD with no major physical injuries other than some bleeding on her hands.

Unit #1 towed by chiefs with heavy damage.

Vehicle #2 was a loaner vehicle and had no license plates. That vehicle was likely not drivable with damage to left rear wheel and side.

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VEHICLE 1 WAS DRIVING W/B ON OLD SHAKOPEE RD W TOWARDS FRANCE AV S WHEN IT WAS ENGAGED WITH ANOTHER WHITE SEDAN (UNKNOWN PLATES) IN A ROAD RAGE INCIDENT. THE DRIVER OF VEH 1 ADMITTED THAT SHE HAD PASSED THE WHITE SEDAN, WHICH UPSET THE DRIVER OF THE WHITE SEDAN. THE DRIVER OF THE WHITE SEDAN THEN PROCEEDED TO PASS VEH 1 AND CONTINUED SWERVING AROUND TO PREVENT VEH 1 FROM PASSING THEM. THE DRIVER OF VEH 1 STATED THAT SHE WAS TRYING TO OBTAIN THE LICENSE PLATE OF THE OTHER VEHICLE WHEN SHE DID NOT SEE THE TURN LANE COMING FOR N/B FRANCE AV S FROM OLD SHAKOPEE RD W. AS A RESULT SHE HIT THE TURN TOO FAST AND CRASHED INTO A CONCRETE DECORATIVE BARRIER THAT WAS ON THE MEDIAN DIVIDING N/B AND S/B FRANCE AV. THE OTHER VEHICLE DID NOT END UP CRASHING AND DROVE OFF. IT'S INFORMATION IS UNKNOWN. THE DRIVER OF VEHICLE 1 HAD VALID DL/INSURANCE. SHE HAD NO INJURIES. THE CONCRETE DECORATIVE BARRIER WAS COMPLETELY DAMAGED AND KNOCKED INTO THE S/B LANE OF FRANCE AV S. PHOTOS WERE TAKEN OF THE FRONT END DAMAGE TO VEHICLE 1 AND THE BARRIER. VEHICLE 1 WAS TOWED DUE TO DISABLING DAMAGE.

Vehicle two was parked legally and properly in a parking spot inside of the east parking ramp of the Mall of America. Vehicle two was unoccupied at the time of this incident. Vehicle one was stolen and attempting to flee officers. Vehicle one was boxed in by multiple squad cars. The driver of vehicle one was driving in reverse and then in forward multiple times striking vehicle two. Vehicle one continued the process of striking the front passenger side of vehicle two for an extended period of time causing severe damage to the vehicle. Vehicle three (squad 831) was the squad that initially boxed vehicle one into a parking spot. Vehicle three had parked with the front of the vehicle facing the front of vehicle one, slightly off centered. In the process of vehicle one trying to flee officers vehicle one had struck vehicle three causing cosmetic damage to the front and side of vehicle three.

Unit 1 was driving e/b on Old Shakopee Road at the split to 98th Street. Unit 1 lost control at the curve and ran off the south side of the road. Unit 1 drove through a fence in the back yard of 1400 E 98 1/2 Street and hit a retaining wall in the back yard of 9801 Girard Circle. Unit 2 was walking west on the south side of 98th Street and saw Unit 1 leave the roadway. Unit 2 tried to run east out of the way and was struck by unit 1 after it drove through the fence.

Unit 2 was transported for injuries to the head.

Driver of unit 1 was uninjured.

Driver of unit 1 appeared confused about the events. Video of the incident show unit 1 was traveling much faster than the posted 35mph limit.

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On 2/28/2024 at approximately 1610 hours, Unit 1 was reported to be traveling west bound on 84th St W. Unit 1 was taking a left hand turn to go south bound on Stanley Ave S when he failed to yield to oncoming traffic and was struck by Unit 2. Unit 2 was traveling east bound on 84th St. W. at the intersection of 84th and Stanley Ave S when she reported to enter the intersection through a yellow light when Unit 1 turned in front of her. Unit 2 struck the right side side of Unit 1 causing Unit 1 to spin around hitting the front of Unit 3. Unit 3 was stopped on Stanley Ave S at the intersection of 84th St W at a red light waiting to turn left to go westbound on 84th St. W.

After the accident witnesses attempted to help the driver of Unit 1 who was bleeding from his forehead. Witness reported the male seemed very disoriented and eventually drove off.

A few minutes after officers arrived witnesses and fire noticed Unit 1 which was traveling south bound on Stanley Ave S. Officers stopped Unit 1, the driver was an elderly male who was seen by Allina (run#242358035) but did not get transported. Unit 1 has zero recollection of the accident.

Unit 1 was wearing a seatbelt and no airbags deployed.

Unit 2 was wearing a seatbelt and the airbags attempted to deploy all but were not fully expanded - both the steering wheel and side airbags failed to fully deploy. No injuries.

Unit 2 all were wearing seatbelts, no injuries and no airbags deployed.

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On 02/29/2024 at approximately 1900 hours, Unit 2 returned to his vehicle that had been parked in the first floor parking ramp located at 1550 American Blvd E. The vehicle was unoccupied at this time. Upon returning to the vehicle, he observed that there was a note on the window of his vehicle. The note stated that a witness observed Unit 1 crash into unit two and drive away. The witness stated that the accident occurred on 02/28/2024 at approximately 1300 hours. The witness stated that he took pictures of the damage to both vehicles and was able to get a picture of Unit 1's license plate. No suspect description was provided due to Unit 1 not getting out of the vehicle. Unit 1 never left any information on unit 2's vehicle.
