**PROJECT INFORMATION:**

The City of Bloomington will receive sealed lump sum bids until 11:00 A.M., Tuesday, May 7th 2019, at the City Purchasing Office in the Finance Department at 1800 West Old Shakopee Road, Bloomington, MN for the Bloomington 98<sup>th</sup> & Lyndale Streetscape. Bids received after the time and date designated above for receipt of Bids will be returned unopened without being considered for award. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud in the DAKOTA Conference Room at Bloomington Civic Plaza, 1800 West Old Shakopee Road, Bloomington, MN immediately after specified closing time. All bids submitted are to be valid for sixty (60) calendar days.

**SCOPE OF WORK DESCRIPTION:**

The Bloomington 98<sup>th</sup> & Lyndale Streetscape project includes the replacement of street trees and removal of tree grates and surrounding pavement materials. The new street tree plantings will consist of larger mulched planting beds with perennials . Structural soil will be installed under surrounding new concrete walk for tree root health. This contract will also be responsible for removal of old street lights and adjacent associated concrete walk. Xcel shall supply and install the new LED streetlights under a separate contract with City. This contract shall coordinate their work to reinstall the concrete walk around the new light poles as soon as Xcel has finished installation.

The scope of work for this Project shall include, but not be limited to:

- Erosion Control
- Tree removals
- Pavement removals
- Street light removals
- Excavation (soil removals and disposal)
- Structure soil placement
- Concrete walk
- Tree and perennial planting
- Traffic control

**COMPLETION TIME:**

- Substantial Completion by September 30, 2019.

**PRE-BID MEETING:**

**A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 8:30 A.M. on Tuesday, April 23, 2019 located at the Bloomington Public Works Front Training room, 1800 West Old Shakopee Road, Bloomington, MN 55431.** The pre-bid meeting will allow Bidders an opportunity to familiarize themselves with all conditions that may affect the performance and cost of the Contract. Failure to familiarize oneself with all conditions will not relieve the Bidder of their responsibilities under the contract nor constitute a basis for subsequent contract adjustment.

Bidders shall use complete sets of the Bid Documents in preparing their Bids. The City assumes no responsibility for errors or misinterpretations resulting from the use of incomplete sets of Bid Documents.

In making copies of these documents available, the City does not confer a license or grant permission for any other use of the documents other than for the purpose of obtaining and preparing Bids on the Work.

Each bid submitted must be clearly identified on the outside of the sealed opaque envelope as **“BID FOR Bloomington 98<sup>th</sup> & Lyndale Streetscape** shall show the name and address of the bidder, and shall state the date and time of the Bid opening.

#### **BID SECURITY:**

A certified check or cashier's check payable to the City of Bloomington, or satisfactory bid bond executed by the bidder and a licensed surety company must also accompany the bid in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid to be forfeited as liquidated damages in the event that the bid be accepted and the bidder fail to enter into a written contract and furnish the required bond within ten (10) days after the award of the contract.

#### **BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS:**

The provisions of Minn. Stat. 16C.285 Responsible Contractor are imposed as a requirement of this contract. All bidders and persons or companies providing a response/submission to the Advertisement for Bids of the City shall comply with the provisions of the statute. Per Minn. Stat. § 326B.701, unless exempt, any Person, as defined by Minn. Stat. § 181.723, subd. 1(a), who performs public or private construction services must register with the Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Bidders must submit a copy of their Department of Labor and Industry (DLI) Building Construction Contractor Registration with the Bid.
