Bloomington — Three finalists have been selected to be interviewed for City Manager in Bloomington.

The three finalists are Jay Stroebel, Deputy City Coordinator, City of Minneapolis, Jamie Verbrugge, City Manager, City of Brooklyn Park and Heather Worthington, Deputy County Manager, Ramsey County.

Bloomington has a council-manager form of government. The City Manager serves at the pleasure of the City Council and is the chief administrative officer of the City. The Bloomington City Manager will oversee a staff of 650 full- and part-time employees and total budget of \$188 million, including \$152 million in operating and \$36 million in capital expenses.

Current City Manager Mark Bernhardson is retiring at the end of December after nearly 23 years as Bloomington's City Manager.
