- ✓ Must be an eligible voter in the State of Minnesota
- ✓ Must be able to read, write and speak English
- ✓ Must not be the spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, sibling or stepsibling of any election judge serving in the same precinct or of any candidate at that election
- ✓ Must not be domiciled, either permanently or temporarily, with any candidate on the ballot at that election
- ✓ Must not be a candidate at that election

- I will arrive at my polling place at the assigned time and work until my assigned time or excused by the Head Judge.
- I agree to be courteous, respectful and to assist all voters regardless of race, physical challenge or proficiency in the English language.
- I agree to read the Election Judge Guide prior to Election Day. I will attend the Election Judge Training to learn how to fulfill my assigned responsibilities and conduct the election according to all laws and policies.
- I understand that all judges are responsible for the security of election equipment and supplies and will monitor all such equipment and supplies exactly as instructed.
- I agree to complete all election documentation accurately and completely as required by federal, state and local election laws for my assigned position's responsibilities.
- I agree to report immediately to the Head Judge any malfunction or possible tampering of voting equipment, unusual or suspicious behavior occurring in the polling room or any other event or occurrence that may threaten the accurate gathering or sanctity of the vote.
- I will abstain from making personal and political opinion comments while serving as an election judge.
- I understand that my performance as an election judge will be evaluated according to the duties I perform.
- I certify that all information I have provided on this application is correct and that I have not omitted any information. I understand that giving false information or omitting requested data may disqualify me from further consideration as an election judge or result in dismissal, if discovered at a later date.
- I authorize the City of Bloomington to verify the information I have provided in this application.
