Those organizations and businesses chosen by City staff coordinating the event, and whose products and/or services support the criteria listed below will be invited to participate in the 2021 Bloomington Pride Celebration. Organizations and businesses physically located in Bloomington will be given priority as exhibitors. Organizations and businesses physically located outside Bloomington may be invited to participate if space is available. Participation will be evaluated using the following:

### Criteria:

- 1. Ability of the artisan / organization / business to communicate meaningful information relevant to the event's focus on support of the LGBTQ+ community.
- 2. Prioritization will be granted to artisans / vendors / organizations that are LGBTQ+ owned and/or operated, or who have a primary mission to serve the LGBTQ+ community.
- 3. Timeliness of the artisan / organization / business' request to participate.
- 4. Ability to provide proof of licensure or insurance upon request.
- 5. Preference given to Bloomington based businesses.
- 6. Due to space constraints, not all groups that register for a booth can be accepted. You will be notified on August 5, 2021.

## Restrictions

- 1. The event cannot be used as a fundraising opportunity.
- 2. The event cannot be used as a public forum. Participation is permitted on an invitation only basis.
- 3. Payment is non-refundable unless the City of Bloomington needs to cancel the event.
- 4. The artisan's / organization's / businesses' mission, purpose, and actions must be in harmony with the event's focus on creating an inclusive and welcoming setting for all LGBTQ+ community members to honor and celebrate their contributions in advancing equity and justice in our community and across Minnesota.
- 5. Permission to participate in the event should in no manner be construed as an endorsement or sponsorship by the City of any non-governmental agency, its mission, or message.
- 6. The City specifically disavows legal responsibility for the information provided by the organizations and businesses. The information, views, positions, services or opinions provided by participating organizations or businesses do not necessarily reflect the views, position or opinions of the City of Bloomington.

I understand that I am solely responsible for the items on display and any/all agents, employees and volunteers that participate in the event. I further agree to defend and indemnify the City of Bloomington, their agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising out of, or in any manner connected with, related to, or as a result of my participation in the event.
