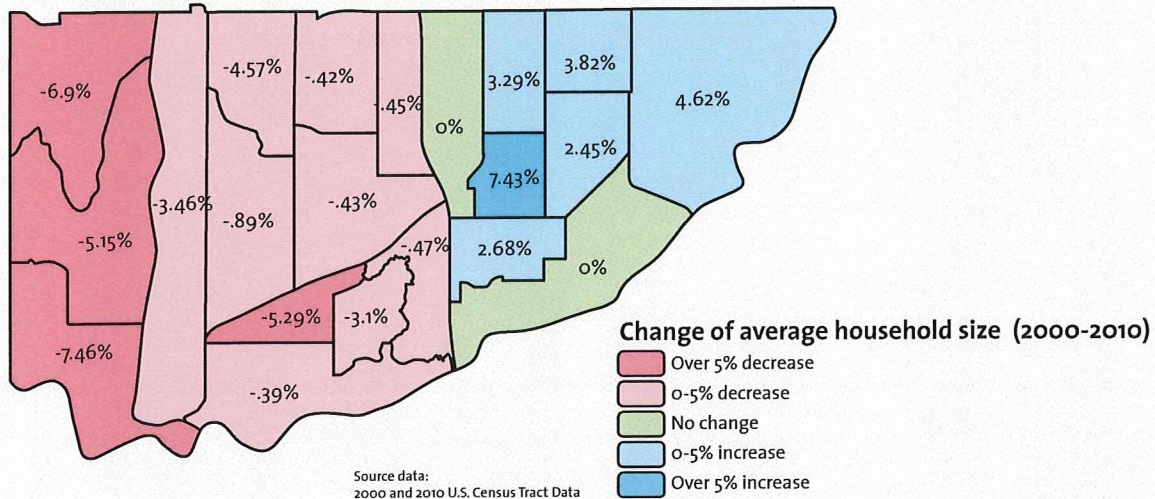

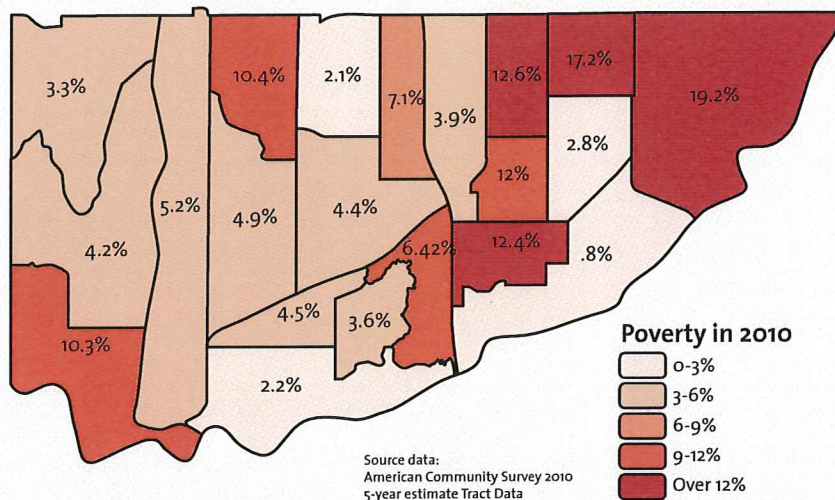


Average Household Size

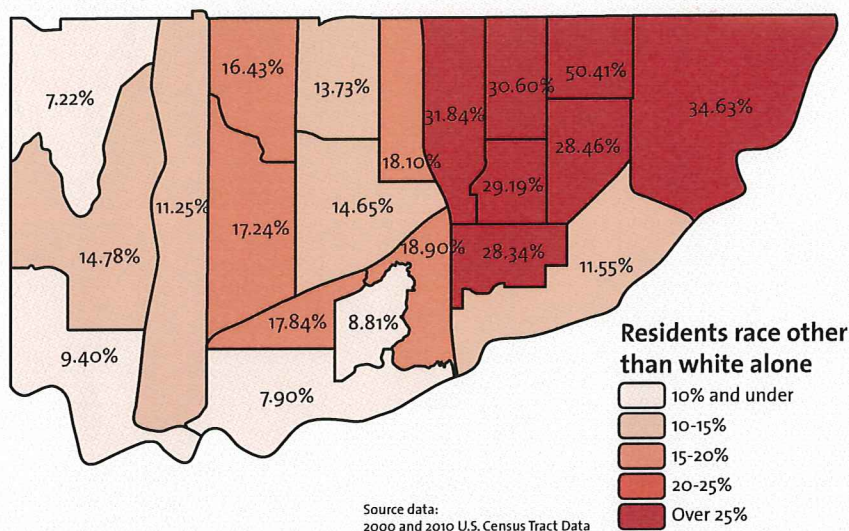

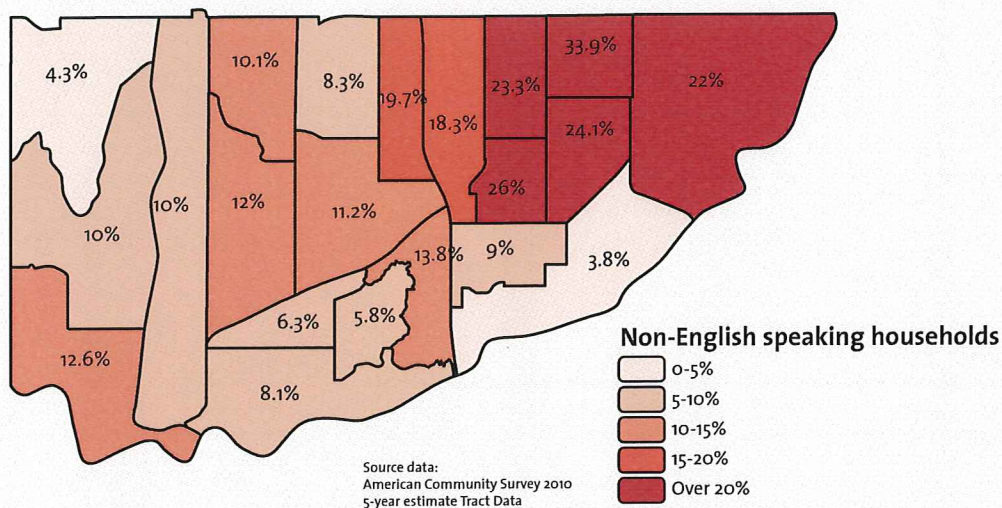
Poverty (2010)

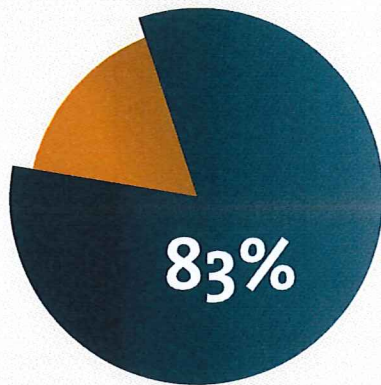

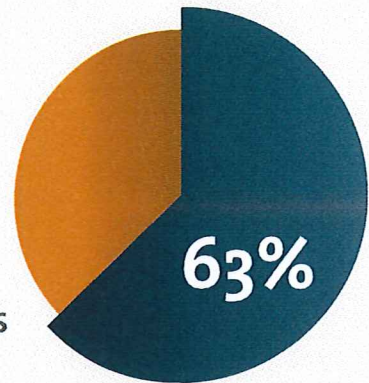
