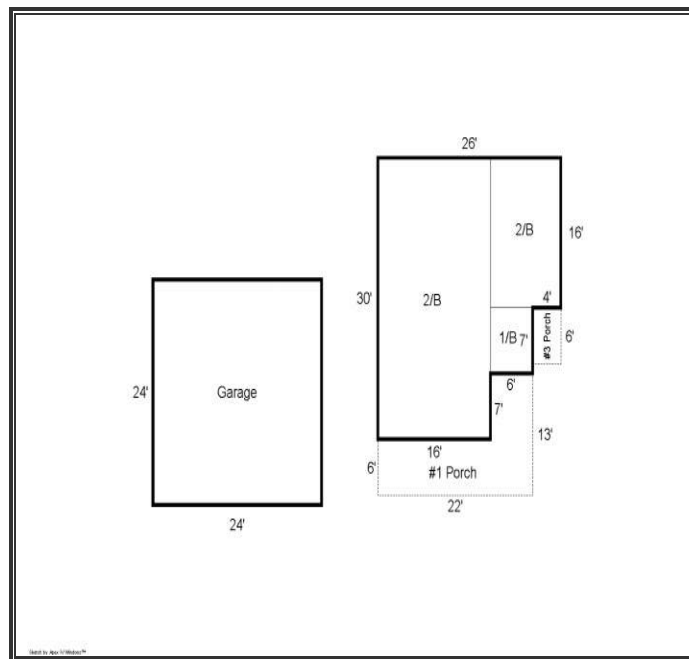
### **HISTORY**

Robert “Doc” Oxborough was the son of Robert H. Oxborough, one of the earliest pre-emptor’s of land in Bloomington. It appears this house was built about the time of his marriage in 1907. Few alterations have been made to the exterior of the “L” shaped vernacular style farmhouse. Original siding and fenestration remain. This is a common architectural style that existing in Bloomington for about a half a century.

James and Christine Scanlon own the property. As a Class II historic structure, the only limitation is a Certificate of Appropriateness must be obtained to remove the structure.
