
HISTORY

Joseph Linke was a member of the Assumption Church. He pre-empted the land in 1853-54 and constructed the home between 1874 and 1879. The T- shaped vernacular farmhouse retains much of its original fabric. Only the roof has modern materials. There was an addition onto the east side of the house, date of the addition not known.

The property is owned by Darwin and Sandra Muzzy. As a Class II historic structure, the only limitation is a Certificate of Appropriateness must be obtained to remove the structure.
