As an owner of a licensed tobacco retail establishment in the City of Bloomington, this serves as notice that there will be a public hearing to consider an Ordinance amending Chapter 14 of Bloomington City Code, related to the sale of flavored tobacco products and issuing of tobacco retail licenses. The public hearing will take place during the City Council's regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, April 26, 2021 at 6:00pm.


- As you call in, provide the item number and item name listed on the agenda. Meeting agenda and documents will be available at blm.mn/meetings by April 23, 2021.

To provide comment prior to the public hearing:

- We will be hosting a virtual input session for current license holders on **Monday, April 12th at 2:00pm** via Webex.
 - After a short presentation on the draft ordinance changes, attendees will have an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments, which will be shared with the City Council. City Council members will not be present at the meeting.
