## 1. What is PSE?

- a. PSE stands for Policy, Systems, Environmental Change (p. 3-4) and includes:
  - i. Organizational (or group) rules, usually written (policy)
  - ii. The way an organization (or group) operates (systems), or
  - iii. Places where people live and spend time (environments)
- b. We will talk more about PSE in the information sessions
- 2. Can organizations outside Bloomington, Edina, and Richfield apply if they serve inside the geographic region?
  - a. Funding must serve Bloomington, Edina, or Richfield individuals and families. The organization can be outside the city limits as long as you are serving residents inside the city (p. 6)
- 3. Can these funds be used to fund a musical production as a tool for community conversations?
  - a. To be eligible the project must meet the 4 requirements (p. 6) and focus on policy, systems, environmental (PSE) change (p. 3-4) that fits with SHIP focus areas (eating, moving, commercial tobacco-free living, and wellbeing) (p. 2-3).
- 4. Do you fund playground equipment?
  - a. Playground equipment is not an allowable expense.
