Please complete the attached form, include payment, and put in an envelope and return to the Skate School Director, Rene Gelecinskyj **no later than December 18**, **2022**.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE? .... EVERYONE! All registered Bloomington skate school skaters are invited to participate. Skaters will be placed in show groups based on their level at registration time, and age. All skaters, no matter what age, gender, or ability are encouraged to participate. Each year we have an all-boy number if we have enough boys sign up. Everybody loves this number every year! The Ice Show is a great opportunity to meet new friends and showcase your new talents to family and friends. It is a professional style show with spotlights, colorful costumes, fun choreography, custom recorded music, and all your skaters! This is a great opportunity to meet new friends and show pictures are available for purchase.

#### DATES TO REMEMBER

- •**Practices** are scheduled for March 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Practice will be sometime between 6pm and 7:30pm. **Note there are NO Saturday practices**. Participant packets will be emailed in February with specific practice times. Each practice is 30 minutes. <u>All</u> practices need to be attended to participate in the show since we only have **3** practice days for most numbers.
- •Costume Measuring is Dec 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> @ 6:30-8pm, Dec 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> @ 9:30-11:30am. If you know how to sew you may measure your own child and turn in the form with measurements and payment **no later than December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022** (see directions on the form under "Skater Measurements").
- •Dress rehearsal is Thursday, March 16th, 6:00-8:00pm.
- •Shows are Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup> @ 7:00pm and Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup> @ 1:00pm.

<u>WHAT IS THE COST?</u> \$125.00 for participation in both ice shows, including professional staff instruction and choreography, practice ice time, show ice time, dress rehearsal ice time, and your costume! (Adults are \$85.00 – does not include a costume)

You may pay by credit card, cash, or check. **NO REFUNDS AFTER December 17<sup>th</sup>.** Registration is NOT available online. Please note the registration form on the following page.

**INFORMATION PACKET** - Participants will receive a <u>Show Information Packet</u> in February that includes all details about the show. Please watch for postings at the rink regarding the show, including show volunteer opportunities. **Make sure to include your email on the registration form to receive show correspondence.**


### **Skater Measurements**

To measure on your own, use a pliable tape measure and measure over clothing following these directions:

- 1) With arms straight out to side, place tape measure around each of the following: bust/chest (1), waist (2) and hips (3), making sure each measurement is at the **fullest** part of the body. The measurements should be comfortable and not tight.
- 2) The girth measurement (4) is as follows: Place the beginning of the tape measure on the child's left shoulder. Keep the tape secure at the shoulder and go down the front of the body, through the crotch and up the back to the left shoulder where you're holding the other end of the tape measure. THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT MEASUREMENT! It should be at least 40"
- 3) The pant inseam is from the crotch down to the ankle bone.
- 4) List all sizes on the right-side including height and weight.
- 5) If you want us to know any special sizing, please let us know in the space provided.
