## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 15**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A: ADMINISTRATIVE RELIEF AND FEE SCHEDULE OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO FEES FOR LICENSES AND PERMITS
