Hit and Run Property Damage crash:

On Friday 8-4-2023, I Officer Koosmann responded to take a report of a hit and run crash (occupied vehicle / suspect plate given) that occurred on 90th Street West at Lyndale at about 1136 hours.

The suspect vehicle was not located.

I made contact with the RP / Victim Theodore Weidman and his wife Lorelei Weidman where they had parked on Aldrich and 90th.

The Weidman's vehicle was a red 2020 Ford Escape with MN plates KEL043 registered to Theodore.

I observed and photographed damage to the Ford Escape. Scrapes and light blue paint transfer on the left rear bumper and side panel behind the rear wheel. (Uploaded to Axon under BP23008294). The vehicle was drivable.

Theodore Weidman explained that he was the driver and his wife was the front seat passenger. He said that he was facing west at a red light at Lyndale, stopped in traffic. He was in the left lane to continue west on 90th street. He said that the other vehicle was trying to get from behind him and into the the left / southbound turn lane to go south on Lyndale. He said that the other vehicle hit his left rear side with it's right front side as it misjudged how much room it had to get over striking his vehicle at a slow speed. He and his wife observed a female driver who looked at them with wide eyes. They described the suspect female as black or possibly Hispanic with black hair pulled into a pony tail. They wrote down the rear license plate as KAH547 and observed the vehicle drive south on Lyndale making no attempt to stop and exchange information with them. They could only describe the vehicle as a newer vehicle that was small and light blue in color.

The suspect vehicle plate (KAH547) registers to Jorge Villegas Villarroel to a 2014 Nissan Versa, blue out of Minneapolis.

A state Crash Report also completed because a suspect plate was provided.

Forward to Traffic Investigations.

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VEHICLE 1 WAS TRAVELING WESTBOUND ON KILLEBREW DR WHEN THE FRONT END STRUCK THE LEFT SIDE OF VEHICLE 2. VEHICLE 2 WAS ATTEMPTING TO MAKE A LEFT TURN FROM KILLEBREW DR TO 20TH AVE WHEN IT WAS STRUCK IN THE LEFT SIDE.

DRIVER 1 STATED SHE WAS TRAVELING WEST ON KILLEBREW DR. DRIVER 1 STATED HER LIGHT HAD JUST TURNED YELLOW WHEN VEHICLE 2 HIT HER.

DRIVER 2 STATED SHE WAS AT A COMPLETE STOP ON TRAVELING EASTBOUND ON KILLEBREW DR WHEN THE LEFT ARROW TO TURN ONTO SOUTHWEST CT HAD TURNED GREEN. DRIVER 2 STATED SHE WAS TURNING LEFT ONTO SOUTHWEST CT WHEN VEHICLE 1 HIT RAN A RED LIGHT AND STRUCK VEHICLE 2 ON THE RIGHT SIDE.

WITNESS 1 STATED HE WAS BEHIND VEHICLE 2 IN THE LEFT TURN LANE. HE STATED VEHICLE 2 HAD A GREEN ARROW AND WAS ATTEMPTING TO MAKE A LEFT TURN WHEN VEHICLE 1 RAN A RED LIGHT AND STRUCK VEHICLE 2.

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On 08/06/2023 at approximately 2026 hours, I Officer Style was dispatched to a personal injury accident at 98th St E and Portland Ave S.

The first vehicle (Unit 1) was a 2006 Red Chevrolet Equinox bearing Minnesota registration plate (ADG652).

The second vehicle (Unit 2) was a gray 1999 Toyota Corolla bearing Wisconsin registration plate (409XYJ).

Unit 2 was stopped at the stop light on eastbound 98th St E at Portland Ave S in the left hand turn lane. When the left hand signal turned green unit 2 began to follow the van in front of him to get onto northbound Portland Ave S.

When unit 2 entered the intersection turning left he collided with a vehicle that was driving westbound on 98th St E.

Unit 2 never saw the vehicle he collided with until after the accident.

Unit 2 advised me that he was feeling light headed and lost consciousness after the collision.

Unit 2 advised me that after the collision the red Equinox attempted to drive away, but could not.

Unit 2 attempted to get information from the driver of the red Equinox, but the driver did not speak English.

Unit 2 advised me that the only thing the driver of the red Equinox told him was "no police"

I spoke with the witness and she stated the following:

Witness was behind the red Equinox (unit 1) that hit unit 2 when she was stopped at the intersection in the westbound lane of 98th St E and Portland Ave S preparing to continue straight through Portland Ave S on 98th St E.

The witness stated the red Equinox (unit 1) was in the first lane preparing to continue on westbound 98th St E.

When the left hand turn arrow turned green for westbound traffic on 98th St E to turn onto southbound Portland Ave S, the red Equinox (unit 1) continued straight through the red traffic light at Portland Ave S and collided with unit 2's gray Corolla.

I then spoke with the driver of the red Equinox (unit 1) and had to use the language line translator to help interpret between English and Spanish.

I asked unit 1 if he needed medical attention and he declined.

I asked the driver of unit 1 for his drivers license and proof of insurance and he stated he did not have a drivers license or insurance for the vehicle.

I asked the male driver of unit 1 if he had anything that had his picture and full name and date of birth on it.

He advised that he had his Ecuadorian passport at his home.

Unit 1 had called people he knew and 5-6 people arrived on scene, but no-one could provide proper proof of unit 1's identification and or insurance for the vehicle.

One of the males showed me a photograph of an insurance card, but the insurance card did not have any information regarding what vehicle the insurance card was for.

Due to officers being unable to positively identify the driver of unit 1 he was placed under arrest for driving an uninsured vehicle and driving without a valid drivers license.

The driver of unit 1 was transported to Bloomington Police Department Jail to have his finger prints taken and sent to the Federal Bureau of Investigations to help properly identify the male.

The red Equinox (unit 1) was towed from the scene to Chiefs towing due to it being inoperable.

There were no signs of impairment coming from unit 1 on scene.

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Two Vehicle crash. One cited for going through red light.

On Tuesday 08-08-2023 at about 0924 hours, I Officer Koosmann responded to Killebrew Drive and Gate 2 at the Mall of America for a two vehicle crash.

I located the crash finding MN plate 359XRK (unit 2) and Nebraska plate 10E689(unit #1)had collided and were not drivable.

I spoke to a witness, Amanda Gagnon who said she may have captured the crash on her dash cam and saw Unit #1 drive through a red light and strike unit #2. She was traveling behind unit #1 when she saw what happened. She then called 911.

I checked for injuries and found that 3 parties out of unit #1 had minor injuries and the driver / lone occupant of unit #2 had a left wrist and left knee injury.

Allina paramedics responded and ultimately only transported the driver of unit 2. The others refused.

I spoke to the driver's who both claimed to have the green light.

I found that Unit #1 was west bound on Killebrew with the intentions of continuing through the intersection. Unsure which lane.

I found that Unit #2 was east bound off of the freeway onto Killebrew and was turning left / north into the #2 mall gate.

Mall of America Security advised they had video showing Unit #1 traveling through a red light. (Traffic Officer Merseth was collecting the video and will add it as evidence).

Officer Markham photographed the scene and uploaded the photos as evidence.

Officer Garibay helped interpretation (Spanish Speaking occupants of Unit #1).

Both vehicle's were towed by Chiefs towing as they had severe and disabling damage (private tows)

The driver of unit #1 was cited for failing to obey a traffic control device. (Competed by Garibay)

On 08/10/2023 at approximately 1911 hours, I Officer Style was dispatched to a hit and run report via phone. Dispatch advised me that the accident occurred at Bloomington Ferry Road and Old Shakopee Road W.

I contacted the reporting party (Unit 2) over the phone and unit 2 stated the following:

At approximately 1850 hours unit 2 was traveling southbound on Bloomington Ferry Road approaching the intersection of Bloomington Ferry Road and Old Shakopee Road W.

Unit 2 came to a complete stop at the red light at the intersection of Bloomington Ferry Road and Old Shakopee Road W.

Unit 2 was positioned in the second lane at the intersection with a vehicle stopped in front of her. When the light turned green the vehicle in front of her began through the intersection and made it through without incident.

Unit 2 began to drive through the intersection, but quickly stopped when she saw a vehicle run the red light traveling westbound on Old Shakopee Road W through Bloomington Ferry Road in the second lane.

At the time unit 2 was unsure if she had been in an accident since she did not feel an impact, but when she returned home a few blocks from Bloomington Ferry Road and Old Shakopee Road W she observed a large paint gray scratch on the front bumper of her vehicle.

Unit 2 advised me that her Tesla has a video camera system that records the front, sides and rear of her vehicle.

Unit 2 reviewed the video footage and was able to see the license plate of the vehicle that made contact with her vehicle.

The license plate of the vehicle that struck her was bearing Minnesota registration (JTS-290).

Unit 2 sent me the video and after reviewing the video I could observe that unit 2 had a green light to go through the intersection and I observed the vehicle bearing Minnesota registration (JTS-290) (unit 1) pass in front of unit 2's vehicle after running the red light traveling westbound on Old Shakopee Road W and Bloomington Ferry Road.

It was unclear if contact was made with unit 2's vehicle, but after the vehicle bearing Minnesota registration (JTS-290) (unit 1) passed in front of unit 2's vehicle a small dust cloud was kicked up in the front her unit 2's vehicle.

Unit 2 had minor damage to the vehicle besides a gray paint scratch which is believed to be from unit 1 sideswiping the front of unit 2's vehicle.

Unit #2 was ahead of Unit #1 same direction.

Driver of unit #1 stated he saw someone at the crosswalk standing, not yet in the crosswalk. He said he looked up and unit #2 was now stopped. He tried to avoid hitting unit #2 but rear ended unit #2.

Unit #2 driver said he stopped to allow person to cross on crosswalk.

Unknown exact position of person at crosswalk during crash.

Weather was rainy. dark with street lights.

UNit #1 was towed due to damage. No injuries
