WHAT IS FEE ASSISTANCE?

The Parks and Recreation Department provides high quality recreation opportunities in Bloomington, MN. We offer low cost programs and services that benefit physical, mental, social, and emotional health.

Fee Assistance is available only to people who **live in Bloomington.** You must show a financial need to receive fee assistance for eligible programs and services.

You must complete an application to receive Fee Assistance. Your application must include the correct paperwork proving financial need. Each person in your account will receive a credit. Each child under 18 will receive \$450. Each adult 18 and over will receive \$40.

We will respond to your application in writing within one week. The scholarship will be valid for the calendar year.

You must reapply for Fee Assistance each year.

HOW DO I GET MY LUNCH LETTER?

The Educational Benefits Letter from Bloomington Public Schools shows that your child is eligible for free or reduced lunch. To ask for a copy of your letter, call the Food Service Department at: 952-681-6570

HOW DO I APPLY?

Complete the Fee Assistance Application. Submit your application and required financial documents to the Parks and Recreation Department.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

New and returning families to Fee Assistance can apply **anytime**.

IMPORTANT: You must be approved for Fee Assistance <u>before</u> you sign-up for activities. We do not allow refunds or adjustments for past purchases.

HOW DO I GET MY DISCOUNT?

Wait to sign-up until we confirm your application is approved. After you are approved, you will automatically receive a scholarship fund on your Parks and Recreation account.

HOW DO I KNOW IF I CAN APPLY?

We determine eligibility based on the forms you submit. You must provide *either* one from List A, *or* one from List B and List C.

- If you receive aid from Hennepin County, please obtain verification of your monthly income. You can call your Hennepin County financial worker to request this information.

IS MY INFORMATION KEPT CONFIDENTIAL?

Yes. Everything you submit is confidential. Only the essential staff will see your information.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

If approved for Fee Assistance, you must still pay part of the program fees when you register. You cannot register if your account is delinquent (for example, a returned check). You must pay any debts in order to participate in Parks and Recreations programs.
