Bloomington Business Rebates for Energy Efficiency Upgrades

Center for Energy and Environment (CEE) has partnered with the City of Bloomington to offer rebate funding for businesses making energy efficiency upgrades.

These rebates can cover **20% of the cost (up to \$2,500)** of eligible lighting, HVAC, and refrigeration upgrades on top of regular program rebates.

How it works

- Schedule a **free energy assessment** with CEE's One-Stop Efficiency Shop
- You'll receive a report with recommendations and estimated energy savings and rebates
- Your CEE consultant will guide you through the entire project
- The CEE team will complete and submit all city and program rebate paperwork
- Projects must be completed by November 30, 2025, to qualify
- Rebates are available on a first come first served basis until funds are depleted
