On 10/28/24 at approximately 0502 hours, Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd and Bloomington Ferry Rd for a three car crash. One person involved stated they had back pain. Officers arrived on scene and located two vehicles. Unit #1 was on the South side of Old Shakopee on the porkchop, and Unit #2 was on the North side of Old Shakopee, both West of Bloomington Ferry. Driver of Unit #1 stated they were traveling Westbound Old Shakopee Rd and had the green light at the intersection. Driver of Unit #2 was traveling Southbound on Bloomington Ferry through the intersection of Old Shakopee, and also stated to have the green light. When Unit #2 entered the intersection, Unit #1 struck the front driver side of the vehicle, causing Unit #2 to spin right up and over the curb striking the fire hydrant. Unit #1 turned South and ended on the Southwest porkchop facing South. Driver of Unit #2 had shoulder and back pain and was transported to FVSD Hospital via Allina. Passenger of Unit #1 had lower belly pain from the seatbelt but refused transport. Both Units were towed by Chief's Towing to their lot. Driver and passenger of Unit #1 were picked up by family and brought home. They were advised on self transport to the hospital if they so choose. The person who called to report the accident did not stay on scene and they did not leave any information. Both Units were provided the case number. Due to them leaving the scene, the driver of Unit #1 was mailed a citation for driving without a valid Minnesota driver's license (citation #270124207593).

Unit 1 was traveling through parking ramp at Normandale College (Level 1). Unit 1 was traveling northbound and went around corner to westbound. Unit 1 struck pedestrian (Dunning, Richard).

Driver of Unit 1, Dougherty, was unable to describe where on her vehicle Dunning had hit. Dunning was unable to either at the time of the accident.

Dunning advised he was suffering from leg pain in result of the accident.

Dunning was transported by Allina Paramedics.

Unit 1 was parked at Pump 7 at the gas station. Unit 2 was parked at Pump 2 at the same gas station. (next to each other but at neighboring islands) Unit 1 moved forward and started turning right. The passenger side of Unit 1 made contact with the front driver corner of the parked and unoccupied Unit 2. Unit 2 actually moved on the surveillance video. Driver of Unit 1 stopped for a short time and threw his hands in the air. Unit 1 then continued forward and left the parking lot without attempting to contact anyone connected to Unit 2. Attempted contact with the RO of Unit 1 via phone and text with no response.

UNIT 1 driving Eastbound on 98th ST W from Lyndale Ave S. UNIT 1 in the left lane traveling approximately 35 mph. Driver of UNIT 1 stated they did not see UNIT 2 until just prior to the collision. Driver of UNIT 1 attempted to swerve to the right to avoid hitting UNIT 2 but the driver's side mirror made contact with UNIT 2. Driver of UNIT 1 stated they knew they hit someone but panicked and drove home before returning to the scene 20-30 minutes later. UNIT 2 was laying in the middle of the intersection of 98th St. W. and Pillsbury Ave S. UNIT 2 did not appear to have any major external injuries. Unknown on internal injuries. UNIT 2 transported to Regions Hospital by Allina ambulance. Plastic cover for driver's side mirror was located next to UNIT 2. There was no other damage to UNIT 1 other than the driver's side mirror plastic cover.
