On 05/05/2025 I Officer Atchison-Keolanui #417 was dispatched to 1321 78th St. E. for a report of a hit and run that occurred in the parking lot.

Upon my arrival I made contact with Geraldine Muriel Skogen, and Joel Norlan Skogen who are the registered owners of a 2023 Cadillac XT5 Iowa License Plate (MHJ980).

I observed both of the passenger side doors with damage from another vehicle.

Geraldine's Statement:

Geraldine stated she, and her husband Joel had checked into the hotel around, and last seen their vehicle at 1900 hours on 05/04/2025.

According to Geraldine they have been staying at the Comfort Inn for approximately 4 days now, and are in the process of moving to Minnesota.

Geraldine said there was an employee who was present during the hit and run incident and had video on their phone.

I made contact with staff who stated their driver later identified as Gustavo Cortes-Silvestre was the individual who witnessed the accident.

I made contact with Gustavo who stated the following.

According to Gustavo he was parked on the Southwest side of the Comfort Inn when he saw a black female exit the west side door of the hotel and walk towards a vehicle and enter the vehicle on the driver side.

Shortly after Gustavo said he noticed a black male exit the west side door as well a proceeded to walk towards the vehicle.

Gustavo said he began to hear yelling by the vehicle and the black male pounding on the window of the vehicle occupied by the black female.

Gustavo said he began recording the incident and witnessed the female reverse the tan/gold Acura and drive towards the black male. Gustavo stated the female missed the male but made contact with Gerldine's and Joel's vehicle.

Gustavo said the female reversed again and proceeded to drive towards the south exit of the parking lot.

The vehicle license plate on the vehicle involved in the hit and run was possibly (MSA 647).

Officer Actions:

I took pictures of the damage done to Geraldine's and Joel's vehicle.

Management at Comfort Inn advised the cameras outside of the building did not have any footage of the vehicle hit and run.

I gave Geraldine a case number with my name and badge number.

I sent an Axon link to Gustavo for the camera footage he captured on his phone.

Unit #1 and Unit #2 were east bound on Old Shakopee Road east of Normandale Blvd.

Unit #1 attempted to move from the left lane to the right lane checking for vehicles and not observing any.
Unit #2 was next to unit #1 near the front tractor.

Unit #1 made the lane change and struck unit #2 causing damage to the right side of unit #2.
Unit #2 then left the roadway and ran over a mailbox belonging to 5265 West Old Shakopee Road.

Chiefs Towing was contacted to remove Unit #2 from being stuck on the mailbox.

No injuries. Provided parties with a case number.

State CVI was contacted and did not respond since vehicles were able to drive. (other than being stuck on mailbox post)

On 05/08/2025 Officers were dispatched to an accident involving a bicycle vs. vehicle.

Upon arrival the party on the bicycle (tricycle) was up and walking, but complaining of some minor head pain.

Officers spoke with the vehicle driver who advised he had the green light to travel eastbound and all of a sudden he felt something hit the back of his vehicle. He stopped and observed the tricyclist on the ground.

I spoke with the tricyclist who advised that she does not remember what happened, she knew she was traveling SB Nicollet towards 94th st because that is the way she takes to work.

A unbiased witness, Woodruff, advised that she was right behind the vehicle. They had a green light and were starting to travel through the intersection when the tricyclist darted through the intersection. Woodruff stated she was traveling right down the middle of Nicollet Ave, Southbound.

The tricyclist was transported by Allina due to saying she doesn't remember anything, and she did not have anyone she could contact to care for her. She agreed to go. There was very minor scraping to the bicycle and helmet that she was wearing. No other injuries reported. Conversations captured on Axon BWC.

On 05/10/2025, at about 1008 hours, I responded to the area of 4990 77th ST W., Edina, MN in reference to a hit and run accident which occurred at 8400 Normandale BLVD., in the City of Bloomington, MN.

The reporting party / victim, was now parked at the 4990 address waiting for a police response.

No other information was given.

I arrived and made contact with the victim, Kitty Favreau, who was sitting in her 2024 Subaru Outback, bearing MN 8BY855.

There was minor damage on the front driver side corner.

Kitty stated the following in summary:

Kitty was northbound on Normandale AV approaching W 84th ST.

As she entered the intersection, a silver Subaru made a u-turn in front of her.

The silver Subaru was in the southbound lanes and made a quick u-turn to go back northbound on Normandale BLVD.

Kitty was unable to brake in time and struck the silver Subaru.

Kitty said the other half made the u-turn through the red light.

The silver Subaru continued northbound and did not stop.

Kitty exited the freeway and called police.

Kitty was able to get the license plate of the silver Subaru.

Kitty said the driver appeared to be a younger white female.

No further.

No injuries and no tow.

On 05/10/2025 at approximately 1401 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to the intersection of 106th St W. and Vincent Ave S. for a motor vehicle accident.

Upon arrival, the two vehicles were identified as unit 1 (HUT914) and unit 2 (YBC9467).

At this time, it was observed that unit 1 had moderate damage to the right side of the vehicle near the passenger side door and passenger side rear door. Unit 1 stated that they were unable to exit the vehicle and informed me that their chest was hurting. It should be noted that the only airbag that was deployed was the passenger side front curtain. Unit 1 stated that they would like an ambulance. Unit 1's vehicle required a tow. Unit one's driver was transported to the hospital via Allina.

At this time, I made contact with unit 2. Unit two stated that they were traveling east on 106th St W. near Vincent Ave S. when unit 1 pulled directly Infront of them. Unit 2 stated that they thought that unit 1 did not stop at the stop sign located at 106th St W. and Vincent Ave S. on the north side. Unit 2 had moderate damage to the front end of the vehicle that required a tow.

Around this time, a witness stated they thought that unit 1 did not stop at the stop sign but was no certain.

Unit 2 had a passenger that had minor injuries to their leg but denied transport via ambulance.

Unit one later stated that he was unsure if he stopped for the stop sign. They stated they were traveling south on Vincent attempting to cross at 106th St. W when unit 2 struck them.

No clear contributing factors at this time.

No collision between veh #1 and any other vehicle. Driver #1 stated he had minor injuries, but he declined an ambulance. Driver #1 did say he scuffed his helmet a bit and had minor road rash on his arms.

Driver #1 stated he was northbound on France Ave S. He had a green light at W 90th St. Another vehicle (MN Lic# GPW-372) took a left hand turn from southbound France Ave S to head eastbound on W 90th St. He did not want to hit the other vehicle so he dumped the motorcycle. He did not come in contact with the other vehicle.

The other driver of the vehicle who took the left turn was identified as Jason Archie Monke (10-22-1974). His cell number is 612-360-7726.

Monke stated: He was southbound on France Ave S. He was taking a left turn to go eastbound on W 90th St. He had a blinking yellow arrow. He did not see veh #1 traveling northbound on France Ave S. He did not come in contact with veh #1.
