Unit 1 was eastbound on Old Shakopee Rd passing through the light at Highway 169. Unit 1 saw a yellow light and sped up to approximately 45mph to make the light and struck unit 2. Unit 1 had damage to the passenger side rear tire/quarter panel and was towed.

Unit 2 was at the light to go westbound on Old Shakopee Rd from northbound Highway 169. Unit 2 saw a green light and proceeded through the intersection. Unit 2 saw unit 1 pump the breaks to stop then sped through the light and struck unit 2. Unit 2 had front end damage and was towed.

Witness was behind unit 2 and saw a green light for approximately three seconds when Unit 1 ran a red light and struck unit 2.

Drivers of both units had valid license/insurance and both vehicles towed from the scene.

Preliminary Statement

On 05/27/2025 at approximately 2030 hours, I Officer Okoi #399 came upon a traffic accident at 98th st and Dupont.

Observations/Statements

Upon arrival, I observed Unit 1 facing eastbound in the intersection with moderate front-end damage and Unit 2 facing southbound with moderate disabling damage to the right wheel.

I asked both drivers if they needed medical attention, and both declined. Both drivers were asked more than once.

Unit 2 statement

Unit 2 driver stated she was turning southbound on Dupont Avenue when Unit 1 ran the red light and hit her passenger side front end. Unit 2 stated that she had the green arrow to turn. Unit 2 vehicle was towed by Chiefs towing, and the driver left with family.

Unit 1 statement

Unit 1 driver stated that she was driving eastbound on Old Shakopee when she entered the intersection; she believed she had the initial green light, and once she saw Unit 1 turning, she hit the brakes and collided with Unit 2. Unit 1 vehicle was drivable, and her daughter picked up the driver.

Officer's Actions

I took photos of the accident and uploaded them via Axon Capture. Driver exchanged insurance and contact information.

Dispatched to car accident with no injuries to Walgreens in Bloomington located 9800 Lyndale Avenue S. The crash originally occurred at 106th Street and 35W, under the bridge.

V1 is Jeep, V2 is Audi. Both vehicles were at the semaphore at 106th Street and 35W under the bridge, facing eastbound. Semaphore displayed a red light; V1 could not stop in time due to faulty brakes, admitted by the driver. V1 struck V2 in front of him and left the scene of the accident, but stopped at Walgreens where both drivers were waiting for police. Driver of V2 was concerned that driver of V1 was leaving the crash, possibly misunderstood due to language barrier. Driver of V1 did not have the title of the vehicle that he allegedly purchased seven days ago. Officers were unable to confirm the sale and could not get ahold of the alleged previous owner, "Mikey" who allegedly had the title. Phone number provided Mikey was out of order. Vehicle towed due to safety concern. Driver of V1 issued citation for driving status, uninsured vehicle and faulty breaks. Driver info exchanged.

- V1 was a USPS delivery vehicle on-duty delivering mail.
- V1 waiting for a break in traffic to drive northbound from 2401 90th St W private drive to northbound Queen Ave S by crossing 90th St.
- V2 was eastbound on 90th street in the #2 (curb) lane approaching the T intersection with Queen Ave S.
- V1 drove northbound trying to cross 90th St W.
- V1 front hit the rear passenger door area of V2.
- Both vehicles pulled into a nearby parking lot to exchange info.
