On 07/01/2025 at approximately 1133 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd W. and Nord Ave S. for a motor vehicle accident.

Upon arrival, I observed vehicle two BPU619 pulled off in the right lane. I Observed that there appeared to be no damage to the vehicle. However, vehicle two was pulling a trailer that had a boat on it. At this time, I observed that the trailer had heavy front end damage near the passenger side tire of the trailer. The tire was no longer on the drivers side of of the trailer. In return this resulted in the boat sitting on the ground blocking the right lane.

Vehicle 2 stated that they were traveling west on Old Shakopee Rd W. in the left lane when vehicle 1 collided with with drivers side tire. The collision occurred near Nord Ave S. Vehicle 2 stated that Vehicle 1 was traveling east on Old Shakopee Rd W. in the left lane. It should be noted that there is not a barrier in place.

Vehicle 1 stated they were traveling east on Old Shakopee Rd W. near Nord Ave S. in the left lane. Around this time, Vehicle 2's drivers side front tire made contact with the drivers side tire of the trailer. This resulted in moderated damage to the drivers side front tire and wheel.

Vehicle 1 and Vehicle 2's drivers did not state that they had any injuries. Vehicle 2's boat required a tow due to the trailer being damaged. Once on the tow truck, there appeared to be moderated damage to the bottom of the boat near the stern of the boat. There also appeared to be damage to the side of the boat.

It should be noted that a witness stated that they believe that they saw Vehicle 2 either cross the divider line or swerve near the line. Witness information added to Report.

Pictures were taken at the scene of the crash.

Clear weather conditions and the road was dry.

Both parties were provided with State Crash report number.

Dispatched to a Personal Injury Accident - Dispatch notes indicate the Reporting Party was in a wheelchair, hit by a KIA, states she does not need paramedics at the T intersection on Wentworth Ave S at 86th St W.

Reporting party/Unit 2 advised she was in her wheelchair stopped in the driving lanes at the stop sign where she intended on driving her wheelchair across the road. While Unit 2 was waiting for a gap in traffic to cross the road, Unit 2 struck the back of her wheelchair. No visible damage to the wheelchair and Unit 2 driver denied any injuries and denied medical attention after being offered several times. Unit 2s son, the listed witness was present with her at the time of the accident. Unit 2 stated that her son has developmental disabilities and was upset protecting his mother when he was banging on Unit 1s window. Unit 2 had her son walk across the street prior to my arrival to avoid any issues.

Unit 1 said she was slowly approaching the stop sign when she was looking left (to the west) to check for traffic when she hit Unit 2 from behind. Unit 1 said she did not know what the rate of speed was, but she was not going over 10mph. Unit 1 stated she never saw the wheelchair in the driving lanes. Unit 1 stated she was stopping after realizing she hit the wheelchair when the witness began banging on her window. Unit 1 said there was no damage from the witness hitting her vehicle. There was slight damage/scratches from the where she hit the wheelchair on the front right corner of her vehicle. Unit 1 was valid, clear, with valid insurance. Despite the Unit 1s age it did not appear her age or driving abilities were a factor, but that it seemed to be a blind spot, and she did not see Unit 2. Unit 1 said she no longer drives far distances, just stays close to home and is always cautious. Unit 1 said she got turned around when she took the wrong turn off Lyndale which is why she was at that current intersection. Unit 1 answered all of my questions without issue or delay.

Pictures of where Unit 2 said she was stopped at the intersection was taken. Pictures of the wheelchair and damage to Unit 1 were taken and uploaded.

The T intersection where this accident occurred is extremely busy at this time of day and the sun was extremely bright. It should also be noted there is no pedestrian cross walk at this T intersection.

On 07/04/2025 at approximately 0748 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident located at the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd W. and Nesbitt Ave S.

Upon arrival, I observed that there were three vehicles involved.

Unit one was identified as (679AF9). Unit one was located facing south on Nesbitt near the light on the south side of Old Shakopee Rd W. Unit one had moderate damage to the front end of the vehicle that required a tow. Unit one's front airbags were deployed during the crash and no injuries were reported.

Unit two was identified as (SAC266). Unit two was located in the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd W. and Nesbitt Ave S. Unit two was facing west bound and was laying on the driver's side of the vehicle. The vehicle did not completely roll over but was laying on its side. All airbags were deployed in Unit two. Unit two's driver was injured during the crash and was transported to the hospital. Unit two's vehicle was severely damaged to the front and side which required a tow.

Unit three was identified as (NBU579). Unit three was located just west of Nesbitt Ave S. on Old Shakopee Rd W. facing west bound. Unit three had moderate damage to the front end of the vehicle that required a tow.

At this time, I made contact with unit one. Unit one stated they were traveling west on Old Shakopee Rd W. in the right lane. Once getting to Nesbitt Ave S. Contact was made between unit one and unit two. Unit One stated they had a green light. Once making contact with unit two, Unit two rolled onto its side. This resulted in Unit one facing south on Nesbitt Ave S. Unit one was unsure on where they collided at due to how fast it happened.

Unit two stated they were traveling south on Nesbitt attempting to go straight across Old Shakopee Rd. Unit two stated they had a green light. Upon entering the intersection, Unit one made contact with unit two causing unit two to end up on its side and facing west bound on Old Shakopee Rd. Unit two was unsure on where vehicle one was located.

Unit three stated they were traveling east on Old Shakopee Rd W. in the left when they approached Nesbitt Ave S. Unit three stated they observed unit two roll on its side. At this time, Unit one made contact with unit three. Unit three stated they thought that unit one was trying to avoid the crash which resulted in unit one hitting unit three. Unit three had moderate damage to the front end of the vehicle requiring a tow. No airbags were deployed and no injuries reported.

Roads were dry and the weather was clear.

Driver #2 stated: He was traveling w/b on W 84th St in the left, straight lane. He had a green light and proceeded into the intersection. Veh #1 appeared right in front of him and he struck veh #1. He had looked prior to the collision and saw that veh #1 (s/b on E Bush Lake Rd) had a red light.

Driver #1 stated: He was traveling s/b on E Bush Lake Road in the straight lane. Prior to entering the intersection he was changing the radio. He does not remember what color the light was when he entered the intersection. When he was in the intersection, prior to the collision he did look up and notice that the light was red. He believes that he may have entered the intersection when it was red. He believes the accident is his fault.
