Opening Statement

On 07/11/2025, at approximately 1543 hours, a collision occurred between a vehicle and a bicyclist just south of the intersection of Overlook Dr on Normandale Blvd. The vehicle, a 2008 Toyota Camry (MN License Plate FLY525), was driven by Monicah Bonareri Brouma DOB 10/19/1992, who holds only an instruction permit. The bicyclist, Donald George Paul DOB 01/30/1932, sustained serious injuries and was transported to Hennepin County Medical Center (HCMC) by Allina Ambulance (Run #071125-0472).

Officer Actions/Observations

Upon arriving at the scene, I observed the collision site on Normandale Blvd, just south of Overlook Dr, where the road has a 7-foot-wide shoulder and a posted speed limit of 30 mph. Both the vehicle (Unit 1) and the bicyclist (Unit 2) were traveling southbound, with Unit 2 riding on the shoulder in the direction of traffic. The driver of Unit 1 reported that she veered from the left lane onto the shoulder, striking Unit 2 and causing serious injury. During my interview with the driver, she initially stated she was using her phone and looking down at it prior to the collision. She further noted that she saw the bicyclist but was unable to avoid the collision. Later, she stated her phone was ringing, and she was taking a call at the time of the incident. I confirmed that the driver was operating the vehicle alone, in violation of her instruction permit restrictions, as no licensed driver was present.

Disposition

The bicyclist, Donald George Paul, was transported to HCMC by Allina Ambulance (Run #071125-0472) for treatment of serious injuries (Broken Neck, Brain Bleed, Right Ear torn off, Fractured Clavicle). Brouma was found to be operating the vehicle in violation of her instruction permit and admitted to distracted driving due to phone use. The vehicles speed at the time of the incident remains unknown.
