Unit 2 stated he was driving north on France Ave S when he entered the intersection and noticed Unit 1 was not stopping for the red light they had. Unit 2 stated Unit 1 ran a red light and struck their vehicle.

Unit 2 stated they were having back pain and requested to be transferred to the hospital.

Neither Units needed to be towed, Unit 2 was moved to a nearby parking lot to be picked up later.

Police were engaged in a vehicle pursuit with V1. V1 was WB 494, approaching WB 212. V1 had to slow for the curve on the off ramp. As V1 slowed, V2 was ahead of V1 and was attempting to yield to emergency lights and sirens. As V1 slowed, PD moved into position for a PIT maneuver. V1 swerved towards squad, presumably in an attempt to evade this action. V1 then collided with V2 as she passed and continued to flee in her vehicle.

D2 reported no injuries from the collision.

On 07/17/25 at approximately 1932 hours, I Officer Miller was dispatched to 200 American Blvd W (Sam's Club) parking lot for a report of a hit and run accident. The reporting party (RP) stated that there was a witness who left a note on the windshield of her vehicle with the suspect vehicle license plate, and stated that there was a female in the vehicle. I made contact with the RP in the parking lot next to Unit #2. I immediately observed damage to the rear driver wheel well and bumper. I also observed a piece of plastic from the wheel well on the ground next to the rear passenger tire. Driver of Unit #2 stated she was inside the store at the time of the accident and came out to the note on the windshield. To which the note stated at approximately 1805-1810 hours, a blue Chevy SUV hit Unit #2 and then backed up into a spot behind Unit #2. Unit #1 was bearing MN plate LXJ115. The note also stated that Unit #1 left the lot at approximately 1620 hours.

Unit #2 does not belong to the driver, to which she provided her MN license and provided a copy of the insurance. I provided driver of Unit #2 the case number, I took photos of the damage, advised her to let the registered owner of Unit #2 know there is a report being filed for the accident and if they have any questions to contact the Bloomington Police Department. I advised driver of Unit #2 that there would be some follow up done on my end as well as our traffic unit. Unit #2 was released from the scene.

I then went inside and spoke with Sam's Club staff to see if there was any video surveillance of the accident. Staff was able to locate the accident at approximately 1807 hours. In the video you can see Unit #1 pull into the parking spot next to Unit #2, and hits Unit #2 in the process. In the video you can see Unit #2 rock in motion from the impact from Unit #1. Unit #1 then parks for approximately one minute then backs up into a spot just behind Unit #2 and parks in a spot facing West. A male is observed getting out of the driver's seat, walk past the front and into the store. The male seen did not appear to be a match to the registered owner of Unit #1. Staff advised that they would watch the cameras tomorrow (07/18/25) and track the male to find out who's membership and credit card was used. Staff was advised to call with any information they obtain after that. An Axon link was sent to staff for video footage.

On 07/20/2025 at approximately 1248 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident located at the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd W. and Bush Lake road.

Upon arrival, I made contact with unit two (DHY373). Unit two stated that they were stopped at the stop light located at Old Shakopee Rd W. and Bush Lake road at a red light facing east. At this time, Unit one (2GR934) made contact with the back of her vehicle. Minor damage to Unit two's vehicle occurred at this time. The damage was a scratch on the back bumper of her vehicle. Unit two's vehicle did not require a tow. Unit two was transported to the hospital due to head injury from the impact. No air bags deployed.

Unit one stated they stopped at the stop light however, they pressed on their gas thinking that it was there brake. Unit one's front bumper was damaged during the crash. Unit one's vehicle did not require a tow. Unit one was not injured during the crash. Initially unit one did not stop at the crash due to not thinking there was any damage.

Information was exchanged between the two parties.

Weather was clear and the roads were dry.

Both drivers were valid and both had insurance on their vehicles.
