Driver of Unit 1 was traveling NB on Lyndale Ave.

Driver of Unit 2 was stopped, and turning westbound 86th to southbound Lyndale. Officers were advised that Unit 2 was starting to go through the intersection with the right of way, and Unit 1 proceeded through the intersection without stopping.

Unit 2 collided with Unit 1 on the passenger side, spinning it around.

Driver of Unit 1 was transported by Allina.

MN State Patrol came to the scene and did a CVI inspection of the dump truck involved.

Unit 1 was towed.

Semaphores remained inactive throughout, and it sounds like Hennepin County was working on getting them back online.

Unit 1 was northbound on Lyndale Ave S crossing the intersection with 92nd St W. Unit 1 was in the left of the two straight lanes. Unit 1 stated there was a semi stopped in the right straight lane at the intersection.

Unit 2 was stopped at the intersection of westbound 92nd St W and trying to turn left to go southbound on Lyndale Ave S. Unit 2 stated there was a semi stopped in the right northbound lane of Lyndale Ave S with his blinker on to go eastbound on 92nd St W. Unit 2 said the semi was waiting for her to go in order to make his turn. Unit 2 said she started to move into the intersection to see if it was clear for her to turn when Unit 1 then collided with her vehicle.

Lyndale Ave S does not have any traffic control devices and has the right of way in the intersection. Traffic on 92nd Ave W has stop signs and must yield to traffic on Lyndale Ave S.

The front of Unit 1 struck the front driver side tire area of Unit 2. Both vehicles were disable due to damage. Photos were taken and uploaded to Evidence.com.

- P1 was on the southeast corner of American Blvd and France Ave waiting for a break in traffic to walk westbound across France Ave in the south crosswalk.
- P1 admitted traffic on France Ave had the green light and right-of-way.
- V1 was in the #1 lane of northbound France Ave moving slowly. Another vehicle was slightly ahead of her in the #2 lane of northbound France Ave.
- P1 stepped into view behind the #2 lane vehicle and in front of V1.
- V1 did not have time to stop or swerve.
- V1 front struck P1.
- P1 was knocked to the ground cutting the back of her head.
- V1 stopped immediately to render aid.
- Witness (W1) was waiting at a red light eastbound American Blvd and France Ave.
- W1 saw the crash and got out to assist.

Unit #1 was traveling westbound on 86th St. W. across the intersection of Lyndale Ave. S.

Unit #2 was traveling southbound on Lyndale Ave. S. crossing 86th St.

According to witness and party statements, Unit #2 did not come to a stop across the intersection, believed that she had a green light.

Unit #2 drove into the intersection and collided with Unit #1 who struck with the front of unit #1 to the side of unit #2.

The driver of Unit #1 declined transport.

The driver of Unit #2 was transported where she was diagnosed with a broken arm.

Statement given by Parias Flores:

According to Parias Flores he was driving eastbound in the Elantra on 96th St. E. going approximately 25-30 miles per hour. Parias Flores came to the intersection of 96th St. E. and Chicago Ave which is an uncontrolled intersection, and according to him he did not see Payne who was driving the Tucson already in the middle of the intersection. It was unknown if any maneuvers were made to avoid the impact considering the damage to the front his vehicle.

Statement given by Payne:

According to Payne she was driving southbound on Chicago Ave. S. at approximately 20-25 miles per hour. Payne stated she was already in the middle of the intersection at Chicago Ave. S. and 96th St. E. when she felt the impact of Parias Flores vehicle hit the front passenger side of her vehicle. She said the incident happened quickly and she did not see Parias Flores at the intersection.

**Clark's Statement:**

According to Clark she was in front of Officer McQuillan when taking the exit ramp from Southbound MN-77 to go West on Old Shakopee.

Clark said she had come to a stop at the merge lane due to oncoming traffic going westbound on Old Shakopee Rd. When she came to a complete stop at the merge lane her the rear of her vehicle was struck by Officer McQuillan's Squad #860.

Clark and her passenger stated they were okay and did not need any medical attention.

**Officer McQuillan's Statement.**

According to Officer McQuillan he was behind Clark's vehicle to go westbound on Old Shakopee Rd. from the off ramp southbound MN-77.

Officer McQuillan was looking over his left shoulder to observe traffic going westbound on Old Shakopee and assumed Clark had continued to drive because there was an opening in the flow of traffic going westbound Old Shakopee Rd.

Officer McQuillan began to accelerate and when he turned his head Clarks vehicle was still stopped.

Officer McQuillan collided with the rear of Clarks vehicle at 4 miles per hour according to the dash cam video.

Officer McQuillan wrote a supplementary report regarding the incident.

Responded to a car vs bicyclist crash at France Avenue/Old Shakopee Road West. (OSR)  
Arrived on-scene and talked to bicyclist #1 - Stewart, Aneya Rayshell - 7/19/2008.  
She advised she was on her bike headed south across Old Shakopee Road on the west side.  
She advised a vehicle hit her bike as she was crossing the crosswalk.  
She believed she had a walk/bike semaphore light stating she could proceed south on France across Old Shakopee Road.  
She was being attended to by Allina Paramedics, but stated her leg hurt.  
Spoke with driver of vehicle #2 - Cadena-Rojas, Wilkin Eduardo - 9/16/1993, who advised the following:  
He was eastbound Old Shakopee Road towards France Avenue in the inside lane.  
He had a green light to proceed east on Old Shakopee Road and started to enter the intersection.  
He ran into Stewart as she crossed the crosswalk south on France.  
He advised again he had a green light to proceed east on OSR.

Spoke with witness #1 Schanaman, Daniel James - 9/21/1971, who advised the following:  
He was next to Wilkins vehicle headed east on Old Shakopee Road and crossing the intersection of France Avenue South.  
He advised he and Wilkin's had a green light to continue east through the intersection.  
He advised the bicycle driven by Stewart attempted to veered sharply in-front of Wilkin's car, but he could not avoid her and hit her.  
He advised fault was of Stewart who did not have a green light or crosswalk sign.

Spoke with witness #2 - Rajaeian, Esmail - 12/23/1961, who advised the following:  
He was behind Wilkin's and Schanaman, but was also east on Old Shakopee Road.  
He observed the eastbound Old Shakopee Road had a green light to proceed through France Avenue South.  
He advised the bicycle driven by Stewart came south on France through the intersection and ran into Wilkin's car.  
He advised fault was that of Stewart and stated she did not have the green light to proceed south.

Stewart's mother Turquoise Clark arrived on-scene and transported her daughter home.  
They refused transport by Allina and were advised to seek medical treatment should things change.
