On 09/15/2025, at about 1521 hours, Bloomington School Bus #161T, was dropping children off at the intersection of W 102 ST and Yukon AV S., in the City of Bloomington, MN.

School Bus stopped and activated its emergency / stop arm equipment. All equipment was operating properly.

A student / child, unit #2, exited the bus and walked out Infront of the school bus and passed the front stop arm, east to west.

As unit #2, walked across the roadway, unit #1, passed the bus on the driver side of the bus, northbound.

Unit #1 disregarded the stop arm equipment and proceeded passed the bus and struck unit #2.

Unit #2 (child) was hit and left his feet. He was able to keep his balance and never fell to the ground.

Unit #1 stayed on scene and provided minimal information and eventually left the scene.

Child sustained minor injury and was medically checked by Allina.

Unit #1 and driver were later located and taken into custody and later booked at BPD.

Unit 2 was travelling Northbound on Normandale Blvd. approaching the intersection of 84th St. W. Unit 2 believed to have a solid green light when Unit 2 was making the turn collided with Unit 1.

Unit 1 proceeded further North and rested near the median on the North East corner of the intersection.

Veh 2 was parked in a parking spot facing northbound in the parking lot of 1801 American Blvd E. Veh 2 pulled out of the parking spot and began traveling eb through the lot. Veh 1 was parked in front of veh 2, facing westbound. Veh 2 then made a U-turn to follow Veh 1, eastbound. Veh 1 rammed the back of Veh 2, causing both cars to spin out. Veh 1 came to rest in a wooded area and down the hill from the initial crash/contact location. Veh 2 came to rest partially in the parking lot/wooded area at the northeast corner of the lot/wooded area. Vehicle damage on Veh 1 was on the front bumper area, with airbag deployment. The vehicle damage on Veh 2 included side airbag deployment and a torn off rear bumper.

On 9/18/25 I, Officer Fahey was dispatched to a hit and run report at the Mall of America 8100 24th Ave. S. P4E space D16.

Upon arrival, I spoke to driver of vehicle 2 MN/REG MUU726 who advised the following. Him and two friends were entering their vehicle in the above mentioned spot when a dark SUV (Veh. 1 MN/REG SGU318) backed out of a parking space (southbound) into his vehicle and fled the scene without stopping to exchange information.

According to driver of Veh. 2, he believed the SUV was occupied once by a female driver.

Passengers of Veh. 2 advised they were at the front and rear passenger side doors at the time Veh. 1 impacted Veh. 2 and were almost struck.

Veh. 1 impacted Veh. 2's rear passenger side quarter panel and left a large dent. Veh. 1 had minor damage to the rear passenger side quarter panel and bumper.

MOA security was able to locate the license plate for Veh. 1 and footage of two occupants entering it (driven by a male).

Security footage captured the two occupants of Veh. 1 in an argument prior to entering the vehicle.

Contact was made with the driver and passenger of Veh. 1 and he was subsequently arrested for domestic assault.

He advised he hit Veh. 2 and had too much going on to stop and exchange information.

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Unit 1 was WB on 98th St E approaching Portland Ave S, unit 1 was in the far right lane to go NB on Portland Ave s. Unit 1 did not use a blinker and began to cut over across two lanes to go SB on Portland Ave S from WB 98th St E. Unit 1 had a blinking yellow arrow to turn SB on Portland Ave S. Unit 1 went through the intersection without yielding to EB traffic on 98th St E approaching Portland Ave S who had a solid green light. Unit 1 then collided with unit 2 which was EB on 98th St E at Portland Ave S. Unit 2 had a solid green light. Unit 1 had one front passenger and unit 2 had one front passenger. Both driver and passenger of unit 1 and unit 2 suffered minor injuries and were transported by Allina medics to the hospital. After the collision, unit 1 ended up behind unit 2 causing unit 2 to hit a traffic control sign on the SW corner of the intersection and rip it off ground.

Two vehicle accident. No drivers / passengers were injured. Veh #1 was towed. The front, right of veh #2 struck the rear passenger side of veh #1.

Driver #1 stated: She was heading southbound Normandale Blvd in the left, straight lane. She was stopped at a red light at W 94th St. She thought the light had turned green and started driving into the intersection. She observed some other vehicles entering the intersection from the west heading eastbound. She looked up and saw her light was red about the time she was struck by another vehicle. She believes that she must have entered the intersection on a red light and must have been zoning out. She thinks it was her fault.

Driver #2 stated: She was heading eastbound on W 94th St in the left, straight lane. She was stopped at a red light at Normandale Blvd. The light turned green. She was not the first vehicle. She started driving straight. A car suddenly appeared and she ran into the vehicle.

I spoke to a witness, Jesus, on the phone. Jesus stated: He was heading southbound on Normandale Blvd in the right, straight lane. He was stopped at a red light at W 94th St. The light was still red and the black car (veh #1) started driving into the intersection. The two cars hit each other.
