Preliminary Information

On 10/14/25 at approximately 1543 hours, I Officer Miller was dispatched to the Embassy Suites Hotel (7901 34th Ave S) for a report of a hit and run. The reporting party (RP) would be waiting in the parking lot at the hotel in a silver Mazda 6. Dispatch advised that the suspect vehicle was a small red SUV bearing MN SDD842, least seen getting onto Hwy 77 from Old Shakopee.

Officer Actions/ Observations

I made contact with Unit #2 who stated that both Units traveling East on Old Shakopee Rd in the left lane, Unit #2 was behind Unit #1. They were approaching Old Cedar Ave as they just passed 17th Ave, when traffic began to slow down.

Unit #2 turned on the right turn signal to merge into the right lane to go around the traffic. Unit #2 looked over their shoulder to check for traffic and began merging to the right lane. As Unit #2 was merging over and started to pass Unit #1, Unit #1 then merged over into the right lane, hitting and side swiping the front of Unit #2 and continued driving.

Unit #2 honked their horn and flashed their lights at Unit #1 in an attempt to get it to stop or pull over, but it did not. Unit #1 continued East on Old Shakopee Rd then took the Southbound exit to Hwy 77. Unit #2 followed Unit #1 for a short time before turning off and coming back to Bloomington to report the accident.

Unit #2 did not see who was driving Unit #1, and could not say if it was a male or female.

The damage to Unit #2 was to the driver's front fender and above the wheel well. The impact also effected Unit #2 driver's door, causing pressure when it is opened making a noise that it did not make before. There was red paint left in the damage on Unit #2.

Unit #1 should have damage to the passenger side and possibly the rear passenger wheel well or fender.

Photos of the damage to Unit #2 were taken and uploaded via Axon Capture.

Unit #2 provided a valid MN driver's license and proof of insurance for the vehicle. Unit #2 was provided the case number and advised on the next steps of the process.

4 vehicle crash. Two vehicles towed (veh #1 & veh #2). One driver possible injured (driver #1) who refused an ambulance. The front of veh #1 struck the rear of veh #2. The front of veh #2 struck the rear of veh #3. The front of veh #3 struck the rear of veh #4.

Driver #1 stated: He was southbound on Normandale Blvd in the left lane. Traffic up ahead stopped. He slammed on the brakes and could not stop in time. He hit the vehicle in front of him.

Driver #2 stated: He was southbound on Normandale Blvd in the left lane. Cars up ahead were stopping. He was able to stop and not hit the Tesla in front of him. He then got hit from behind and pushed into the Tesla (veh #3).

Driver #3 stated to Officer Koosmann #266: He was southbound on Normandale Blvd in the left lane. He stopped for traffic. He then got rear ended and pushed into the vehicle (veh #4) in front of him.

Driver #4 stated to Officer Koosmann #266: He was southbound on Normandale Blvd in the left lane. A vehicle stopped in front of him to make a u-turn. He stopped and got hit from behind.

Driver #1 stated: She was driving veh #2 westbound on W 98th St in the right lane. A vehicle pulled out of the private lot to the north and did not stop before pulling out into the lanes of traffic. She tried stopping, but veh #1 struck her vehicle. She does not have a description of the driver of veh #1. The vehicle did not stop.

Passenger of veh #1 stated: They were traveling westbound on W 98th St in the right lane. They were behind another vehicle. Veh #1 pulled out of a private lot and did not stop before entering the lanes of traffic. Veh #1 struck their vehicle. They tried to get veh #1 to stop, but it kept driving. He did not see what the driver of veh #1 looked like.

On 10/18/2025 I Officer Barnum was dispatched to the area of 7800 Normandale Boulevard Frontage Rd. for a mother vehicle crash.

Upon arrival, I observed two vehicles involved in the crash. Unit 1 (MN:FRC964) and Unit 2 (MN:002987).

At this time, I made contact with Unit 2. Unit 2 stated they were traveling north on Normandale Boulevard Frontage Rd when Unit 1 made contact with their vehicle from behind. This resulted in the vehicle being spun around so that it was facing south on Normandale Boulevard Rd. Unit 2 had moderate damage that required a tow. Unit 2's driver stated that they were injured and wanted to be transported to the hospital for back pain.

Unit 2's passenger stated that they were traveling north on Normandale Boulevard Frontage Rd and thought the driver was attempting to turn into the parking lot. While turning, Unit 1 struck the rear end of Unit 2. Unit 2's passenger was a juvenile and not injured during the crash.

Unit 1 stated they were traveling north on Normandale Boulevard Frontage Rd when Unit 2 attempted a U-turn near the entrance to the parking lot. Due to this, Unit 1 struck the rear end of Unit 2. Unit 1's vehicle had minor damage to the front end not requiring a tow. Unit 1 stated they were injured but that they were going to self transport to the hospital.

Pictures were taken by both drivers. Weather was clear and the roads were dry.

Unit 1 had valid insurance but was a revoked driver. Unit 1 was cited for driving after revocation.

Unit 2 was a valid driver with valid insurance.

Both parties provided with report number.
