On 10/30/2025 at approximately 0208 hours my partner Officer Davern #378 aired he had a vehicle fleeing from him southbound on Oakland. Officer Davern found the Unit one inside of the parking lot of Atonement Lutheran Church located at 601 98th St. W.

Unit one was traveling at a high rate of speed when he collided into the rear of a school bus located at the southeast side of the parking lot. It is unknown how the speed at which Unit one was driving, but it did cause significant damage to the front end of Unit one smashing the front windows out and crushing the hood of the car.

The parked Unit 2 sustained moderate damage to the rear of the bus, but it is unknown if the bus is disabled.

Driver of Unit one admitted to Officer Davern that he was under the influence of alcohol. I Officer Atchison-Keolanui #417 found a straw with a white powder-like substance inside of it on the driver's person.

The driver was transported by Allina to Fairview Southdale to be examined for the possible injuries he sustained from the collision and a blood draw/urine sample.

On 10/31/2025 at 1533 hours, I, Officer Justin Schweigert #430 was training in patrol for the Bloomington Police Department. At this time, I responded to a car vs bicyclist at the intersection of American BLVD and Knox Ave S in Bloomington.

I arrived at the scene and located the victim laying in the median after being hit by the driver of vehicle one. The victim was being tended to by other officers and had unknown injuries that would be survivable. The victim was conscious and speaking with responders. Driver stated they were making a turn on a blinking yellow, watching the yellow light (turning east onto American from Knox) and struck the cyclist in the cross walk.

The victim did not make any statements.

I spoke to witness one and two who advised they did not see where the vehicle came from but saw the cyclist get hit while trying to cross north, believing the vehicle was coming from the west.

Witness three and four advised the vehicle was turning from Knox to the north, and east onto American, hitting the cyclist in the middle of the two lanes on American.

Video was obtain from a traffic camera and showed the cyclist proceeding through the intersection after waiting for a vehicle traveling north (turning east) and was struck by vehicle one who was driving south on Knox and turning east onto American.

The lights are not visible but show the cyclist yielding for the vehicle turning east from northbound Knox, failing to yield for vehicle one who was turning east from southbound Knox.

The victim was transported by Allina to HCMC.

Driver #2 (Unit #2) stated that she had been EB on Old Shakopee Rd E, and had activated her right turn signal to make a right turn into the driveway of 817 E Old Shakopee Rd. As she was making the turn, she was struck in the right side of her vehicle by a large semi-truck.

Driver #2 stated that she had activated her turn signal well before making the turn.

She was not injured, and the vehicle sustained moderate damage to its right side. It appeared to be driveable.

Driver #1 (Unit #1 - Semi) also stated that he had been EB on Old Shakopee Rd, and stated that Unit #2 was in front of him. He stated that he suddenly noticed that Unit #2 had its brake lights activated and he attempted to stop and swerved to the right to avoid a collision with the rear of the vehicle.

Unit #1 left the roadway to the right and struck Unit #2 in its right side just into the driveway of 817 E Old Shakopee Rd.

Driver #1 was not injured, and there was no noticeable damage to the front of the semi truck. Driver #1 was not able to provide his medical card as required. Driver #1 also stated that there is a dash camera in the truck and upon contacting his dispatch, they informed him that the video confirmed that Unit #2 had activated her right turn signal prior to the crash. I was not able to view the video on scene.

Insurance information was collected from both drivers. Driver #1 was issued a citation for not having his medical card with him as required. No commercial vehicle inspection was completed as there were no injuries, minor damage and neither vehicle was being towed from the scene.

On 11/1/25 around 0922 hours, Unit #1 was traveling southbound through the intersection to go eastbound on 98th St. making a left turn.

Unit #1 had exited southbound 35W through 98th St. W. & Dupont Ave. S.

Unit #2 was turning eastbound on 98th St. W from Dupont Ave. S. from the right turn lane facing northbound.

As both vehicles passed east of the intersection they collided front of Unit #2 to the passenger side of Unit #1.

Both driver's of Unit #1 & #2 indicated that the operational traffic control device was green.

On 11/01/2025 at approximately 1755 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to the intersection of 84th St W. and France Ave S. for a motor vehicle crash.

Upon arrival, I observed two vehicles involved in the crash Unit 1 (RPY571) and Unit 2 (RLB531).

At this time, I made contact with Unit 1 to obtain a statement. Unit 1 stated that they were traveling north on France Ave S. when they approached the intersection of 84th St W. Prior to entering the intersection, Unit 1 believed they had a green light. However, after entering the intersection Unit 1 realized the light was red and crashed into Unit 2. Unit 1 stated they attempted to stop but due to the roads being wet was unable to in time.

Unit 1 had moderate disabling damage to the front of their vehicle which resulted in a tow. Airbags were deployed during the crash. Unit 1 had suspected minor injuries but denied being transported to the hospital.

Unit 2 stated that they had a green light and were traveling east on 84th St W. attempting to cross France Ave S. Once in the intersection, Unit 1 crashed into the passenger side front and rear door's of Unit 2. Unit 2's vehicle required a tow and airbags were deployed. Unit 2 had a suspected minor injury but denied transport to the hospital.

Unit 1 was cited for failure to obey traffic control device.

Pictures were taken at the scene.

Roads were wet and it was raining at the time of the crash.

On 11-1-2025 at about 1925 hours Officers responded to a single vehicle, rollover crash at the intersection of 84th St W / Penn Ave S in the city of Bloomington. Officers arrived to find the vehicle flipped and resting on his passenger side in the front yard of 8401 Penn Ave S, just a few feet away from the house itself. The driver, D1, and sole occupant was helped out of the vehicle (V1) by two witnesses, W1 and W2 and admitted to them that he had been drinking. W1 was walking on 84th St W near Penn Ave S and observed V1 travelling EB on 84th St W approaching Penn Ave S and went through a turning red, red light. V1 made no attempt to turn or brake and struck a large boulder in the yard of 8401 Penn Ave S before flipping on his passenger side and came to rest. W2 stated she was in her vehicle facing NB on Penn Ave S at 84th St W at a red light. W2 got a green light and then V1 came through the intersection EB and crashed into the yard at 8401 Penn Ave S. D1 stated he was okay and declined to get evaluated by medics, but had no obvious injuries. D1 declined to make any further statements. D1 had alcohol on his breath, bloodshot watery eyes, and slurred speech. He was placed under arrest for DWI. Furthermore, there were open containers of alcohol in the vehicle along with marijuana residue and THC products. Homeowner of 8401 Penn Ave S was contacted. The house itself at 8401 Penn Ave S, was damaged as well as the vehicle struck the side of it and caused significant damage on both the outside and inside walls. V1 was towed and impounded by Chief's towing. Plates impounded as well. No valid insurance located inside of v1.
