Veh 1 had just was EB 98th St W prior to Dupont Av S. Witness stated Veh 1 was driving at a high rate of speed and ran the red light at 98/Dupont. Veh 2 was exiting 35W S and turning EB onto 98th St. Veh 2 had a green light. As Veh 2 was entering the intersection, Veh 1 blew the red light causing the crash. Veh 1 spun around and went over the curb into WB traffic. Veh 2 then made contact with Veh 3.

Veh 1 driver at-fault and was cited for the red light. Veh 1 driver admitted running the red light and speeding 45-55MPH in a posted 35MPH zone.

On 11/18/2025 at approximately 0759 hours, I, Officer Stevens #384 responded to the the address of 8157 14th Avenue South on the report of a Spanish speaking only person's vehicle being damaged and license plates stolen from their vehicle.

Bloomington Police Department (BPD) Dispatch updated that the suspect was possibly in a black Jeep Cherokee, and had been texting the R/P from the phone number 720-756-5129.

BPD Dispatch advised that the possible suspect was Bermudez Sepulveda, Carlos Arturo DOB: 11/13/1996.

Actions/Observations:

I arrived to the above address and in the parking lot to the South of the address was a black Dodge Durango (original MN Plates: GND065) with a broken rear window, with glass on the ground.

I met with the reporting party (R/P), Suarez Pineda, William Stiven DOB: 04/23/2004 in the parking lot.

I utilized the Propio One interpreter application to communicate with Suarez Pineda.

Suarez Pineda stated that he got into an argument with Bermudez Sepulveda while at a party in Eden Prairie (unknown location, in an apartment) sometime around 0200 hours and the Bermudez Sepulveda damaged his Durango.

The black Durango was parked in the lot to the South of the address (see photographs for location).

There was scratching on the rear driver side bumper, on the driver side of the Durango there was a large dent and scraping on both the front and rear driver side doors.

The front windshield had circular cracking on the passenger side windshield as if someone punched it.

Estimated damage to repair the Durango is \$5000.00.

Suarez Pineda stated that the paper temporary license plates were ripped from the vehicle and missing.

Suarez Pineda stated that Bermudez Sepulveda stole from his boss two months ago, and while at the party Bermudez Sepulveda became increasingly angry at him.

Suarez Pineda stated that he left the party and continued to argue with Bermudez Sepulveda via text message, at one point sharing his home location with him.

Suarez Pineda stated that at 0758 hours he received a text message from Bermudez Sepulveda telling him to come outside.

Suarez Pineda stated that Bermudez Sepulveda smashed out the rear window of the Durango, stating that he saw him cause the damage.

Suarez Pineda stated that he went outside of the home and Bermudez Sepulveda struck his vehicle with a black Jeep Grand Cherokee, however called back later, at approximately 1058 hours, and stated the vehicle Bermudez Sepulveda may have used to crash into the Durango was a red Monte Carlo that belonged to the Bermudez Sepulveda's sister.

Suarez Pineda stated that someone he knows saw the red Monte Carlo in Eden Prairie with front end damage.

Suarez Pineda stated that Bermudez Sepulveda possibly worked on houses in Lakeville in the area of 17901 Gelnoa Drive.

Both the Eden Prairie and Lakeville Police Departments were notified and unable to locate the suspect.

Photographs of the damaged Durango and text messages between Suarez Pineda and Bermudez Sepulveda were uploaded to Axon Evidence.

BPD Dispatch entered a KOPS alert for the suspect and updated the suspect vehicle information.

The neighbor at the 8161 14th Avenue South address has a camera above their doorway, however nobody was at the address at the time of the call.

Suarez Pineda was given this report number.
