Driver of UNIT 1 stated they were making a left hand turn from Penn Ave S onto 82nd St W. While making the turn Driver of UNIT 1 stated they hit UNIT 2. Driver of UNIT 1 thought they had a solid green turn arrow but could not remember for sure if it was solid green or flashing yellow. Driver of UNIT 2 stated they were driving north on Penn Ave S. and were positive they had a solid green light to proceed through 82nd St W. Driver of UNIT 2 stated they saw UNIT 1 approaching but did not have enough time to slow down before the collision. UNIT 1 sustained heavy front end damage and had side curtain airbags as well as driver's airbag deployed. UNIT 2 had moderate damage to the front driver's side bumper. Both vehicles were towed due to damage by Chief's Towing. Driver of UNIT 1 and of UNIT 2 were both transported to the hospital via ambulance. Driver of UNIT 1 had minor pain. Driver of UNIT 2 had difficulty breathing and chest pain.

Driver #1 (Tesla) stated that he had been WB on 85th St W at Blaisdell Ave S. He was not sure exactly how the crash had taken place.

Driver #2 (Subaru) stated that she had been SB on Blaisdell Ave S at 85th St W. The crash happened at the intersection.

Witness #1 had also been WB on 85th St W and state that Unit #1 (Tesla) slowed for the intersection at Blaisdell Ave S, but did not stop before proceeding WB. She could not see what Unit #2 (Subaru) did from her perspective. She did not notice that either vehicle appeared to be speeding.

This is an uncontrolled intersection in a neighborhood (no stop signs for traffic in any direction). It appears that both vehicles arrived at the intersection at the same time and neither driver saw the other vehicle and they collided in the intersection. Based on the damage to both vehicles, it did not appear to me that either was traveling at an excessively high rate of speed. It is unknown, though, if either was speeding.

Unit #1 sustained moderate/disabling passenger side damage and was towed from the scene.

Unit #2 sustained heavy/disabling front end damage and was also towed from the scene.

Driver #1 stated that he was not injured.

Driver #2 did not appear injured, but was checked by Allina paramedics for high blood pressure. She was not transported to the hospital.

On 11-11-2025 at 17:49 hours, officers were dispatched to 90th St W / France Av S on a PI crash where one of the vehicles was rolled over. Upon arrival VEH 2, NDM-709, was rolled over on it's side with the driver trapped inside of the vehicle. VEH 2 had severe disabling damage to the front of the vehicle, as well as damage all around the exterior of the vehicle.

The other vehicle involved, VEH 1 was also in the intersection and severe front end damage. Officers and the fire department were able to extricate the driver of VEH 2. Officers spoke to both the drivers of VEH 1 and VEH 2.

The driver of VEH 1 stated she was driving N/B on France Av S towards 90th St W and had a green light to drive through the intersection N/B. As she was driving through she collided into VEH 2.

The driver of VEH 2 stated he was driving S/B on France Av S approaching 90th St W and was in the process of turning E/B onto 90th St W to go east on 90th. As he was turning, he and VEH 1 collided causing his vehicle to rollover.

The driver of VEH 1 had a laceration on her right knee and was transported by Allina medics to FVSD for treatment. The driver of VEH 2 had a possible left leg injury, but he refused transportation. Both drivers had valid insurance and valid licenses. There were no witnesses.

Both vehicles were towed to Chief's towing lot due to disabling damage. Photos were taken of the scene and uploaded to Axon.

On 11/15/2025 at approximately 1424 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to the intersection of 78th St west and Nicollet Ave south. for a motor vehicle crash.

Upon arrival, I observed two vehicle's that were involved in the crash. Unit 1(KLP935) and Unit 2 (SJK157).

At this time, I made contact with Unit 1's driver. Unit 1 stated that they were stopped at the stop sign located at 78th St E. and Nicollet Ave S. facing west. Unit 1 stated that they thought the intersection was clear so they entered in an attempt to turn south on Nicollet Ave S. Once in the intersection, contact was made with unit 2 who was traveling south on Nicollet.

Unit 1 had moderate damage to the front bumper of their vehicle which did not require a tow. Unit 1 stated they were not injured during the crash and neither was the passenger. Airbags not deployed.

Unit 2 stated they were traveling south on Nicollet Ave S. when they approached the intersection of 78th St E. Unit 2 stated they were traveling in the left lane. Once entering the intersection, unit 1 made contact with the left rear driver side quarter panel of their vehicle.

Unit 2 had moderate damage to the driver side rear quarter panel that did not require a tow. Unit 2 stated they injured their back during the crash but refused transport. Unit 2 was going to drive to the hospital themselves. Airbags not deployed.

Both drivers had valid insurance and were valid drivers.

Weather was clear and the roads were dry.
