driver of unit 2 did not speak English. unit two was in middle of intersection when the front of unit 1 struck the rear driver side of unit 2.

WITNESS stated unit 2 came to a complete stop at a red light on nb france ave s at 98th st. witness stated after coming to a stop, unit 2 then proceeded through the intersection despite it being a red light, which then caused the crash with unit 1.

On 12/17/25 at approximately 1549 hours, I, Officer Miller was dispatch to the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd and 12th Ave for a report of a minor personal injury crash. Dispatch advised that Hennepin County was on scene and they requested Allina for shoulder and neck pain.

I arrived on scene and located Deputy B. Becker #22 who was with an older female that was speaking with Allina paramedics. Deputy B. Becker #22 stated she was driving by when she came across this accident and assisted. The woman speaking with Allina was stating she had some shoulder and neck pain and just wanted to be checked out. She was the passenger in the vehicle.

The driver of Unit #1 was on the corner with the driver of Unit #2.

Everyone stated they were ok and did not need medical attention. I asked what happened and the following is what the driver to Unit #1 stated;

Both vehicles were traveling Eastbound on Old Shakopee Rd in the left lane. Unit #2 was stopped to make a left turn onto Northbound 12th Ave. Unit #1 was behind Unit #2 and slowed down and came to a stop. Unit #1 was attempting to go around Unit #2 into the right lane. Unit #1 was attempting to pull into the right lane but did not see the oncoming vehicle. Driver of Unit #1 stated he was going about 15MPH when he hit Unit #2 on the rear passenger side. Driver stated he did not have enough time to step on the brake before hitting the truck.

Unit #1 had very heavy front end damage that was disabling the vehicle. Airbags in the front passenger compartment were deployed.

Unit #2 had very minor damage to an attachment on the rear passenger side. USDOT 2540418 was listed on the cargo part of the truck, and USDOT 2881058 was listed on the driver door.

Driver of Unit #2 stated that he has been trained in inspection of their trucks and did a full inspection, stating the vehicle is safe to drive and does not have any disabling damage. Driver of Unit #2 also informed his boss that rents the truck and their insurance.

Driver of Unit #1 informed the registered owner of the accident and the condition of the vehicle.

Insurance and driver's licenses were provided on scene.

Both parties were given the case number and advised to contact their insurance with that listed number.

Chief's Towing took Unit #1 to their lot due to the disabling damage.

Deputy B. Becker #22 drove driver of Unit #1 and the passenger to a nearby area for them to be picked up.
