

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-61

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY CODE RELATED TO CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

The City Council for the City of Bloomington, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. That Chapter 2 of the City Code is hereby amended by deleting those words within brackets and ~~[stricken through]~~ and adding those words that are underlined, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 2: ADMINISTRATION

ARTICLE V: CITY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

DIVISION A: GENERAL PROVISIONS

§ 2.72 COMMISSIONERS.

(d) Service limits. No member may serve a consecutive period of more than six years on a particular commission, except that a member may serve until a successor is appointed and qualified. No service limit shall apply to members of the Board of Review ~~[or to members of the City Council serving on a commission]~~. When a person is appointed to a vacancy on a commission, the unexpired portion of the term for that year of appointment shall not be counted in computing the maximum permitted service on a commission. Any commissioner may serve more than six years on a particular commission provided there is at least a one year separation period between the six-year consecutive period and the next term.

DIVISION D: CREATIVE PLACEMAKING COMMISSION

§ 2.82.03 MEMBERSHIP.

The Commission shall consist of nine members. At least five of the nine members shall be residents of the city. A commissioner may also be ~~[a City Council member, or]~~ a member of another city advisory commission.

DIVISION H: SUSTAINABILITY COMMISSION

§ 2.86.03 MEMBERSHIP.

The Sustainability Commission shall consist of ~~[11]~~nine members, including at least two young adults. The majority of the members shall be technical experts in one or more of the areas of sustainability ~~[and one seat shall be reserved for a City Council member]~~.

Section 2. This Ordinance is effective upon publication, except that the amendment to reduce the number of members provided for in City Code Section 2.86.03 shall be achieved through the existing requirements set forth in City Code Section 2.72 and related attrition.
