Rebate Program Guidelines

- The rebate program is only available to customers of the City of Bloomington Water Utility. Rebate devices must be installed within the City of Bloomington.
- Rebates are for **residential properties only**. This includes single-family homes, condominiums, townhomes, or duplexes.
- New WaterSense or EnergyStar devices must be replacing an existing, less efficient device. New construction and new development are ineligible for rebates.
- Rebates will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis until all rebate funds as allocated are exhausted, or until June 30, 2026, whichever comes first.
- Each Bloomington water account is limited to two rebate claims.
- Upon approval, rebates will be issued as credits on the water utility bill. No rebate checks will be issued.
- Only qualifying purchases made on or after July 2, 2024, are eligible for the rebate.
- The City of Bloomington reserves the right to conduct inspections to verify the installation of products at the specified address. Utility Bill credits will be revoked if products have not been installed at the location specified on the rebate application.
- You must provide receipts and information about the make and model of the device at the time of application.
- The City reserves the right to amend or terminate the rebate program at any time.



Funding for the rebate program is provided by the Metropolitan Council and Clean Water, Land & Legacy Amendment's Water Efficiency Grant, the Nine Mile Creek Watershed District, the Bloomington Sustainability Commission, and the Bloomington Water Utility.
