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Unit 1 was eastbound on 98th street west in the left lane, just east of the intersection with Penn Ave S. Unit 1 driver said he did not remember exactly what happened but he drifted out of his lane and up onto the concrete center median striking a sign causing damage to the front driver of the vehicle. Unit 1 driver initially made a comment about another vehicle but also said he may have been looking down when the crash occurred.

Unit 1 was able to be driven away from the scene. The sign that was struck belongs to Hennepin County and they were notified. The sign indicates the start of a raised center media.

Initial observations:

When I arrived on scene, I observed a 2020 Jeep Cherokee with Minnesota license plate ETB119 was in the middle of the intersection with heavy driver side damage to both the front and back passenger side door.

The airbags to the Jeep Cherokee were deployed.

The parent of the driver and registered owner of the Jeep, identified as Richard Keith Hunt, was on scene prior to my arrival.

Richard stated his daughter Margaret Joan Wilton was the driver of the Jeep.

Margaret was sitting in the passenger seat of her parents other vehicle and appeared to still be shaken from the accident.

Margaret gave the following statement:

According to Margaret, her friend's Olivia Jane Raleigh, and Elizabeth Look were leaving a bonfire party at the residence of 10117 Beard Ave. S.

It should be noted I attempted to call Elizabeth, and her mother Heather Look to verify information but was unsuccessful.

Voicemails were left for both Elizabeth and Heather on their cellphones.

Margaret stated she was "traveling northbound on Beard Ave. S.

According to Margaret she reached the intersection of 101st St. W. and Beard Ave. S. when she attempted pressed on her brakes and attempted to make a U-turn.

Margaret said the driver of the 2017 Audi Q5, with Minnesota License Plate PRB722, was behind her coming at a high rate of speed northbound on Beard Ave. S. from the same party and collided into her driver side front, and passenger door.

Margaret knew the driver of the Audi and identified him as [REDACTED].

I later confirmed his full name as [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] drivers license address matched the registration address of the Audi Q5.

According to Margaret, [REDACTED] stopped after the accident occurred and got out of the car telling Margaret, "I'm sorry, I didn't know you were braking."

Another quote [REDACTED] had said was "his parents were going to kill him."
According to Emily Jane Hunt, and Lisa Marie Sanmartin, when they advised [REDACTED] to wait until police arrived, he told them, "I can't I have curfew I need to leave."
[REDACTED] had a couple of passengers inside his vehicle, but it was unknown who those passengers were.

[REDACTED] fled the scene of the accident and drove the Audi Q5 back to his home/residence.

It was confirmed that the Audi Q5 involved in the hit and run was parked inside of the garage of [REDACTED] by Officer Plant #274.
See Officer Plant's supplemental for further on his observations at the residence.

Emily Hunt's Statement:

According to Emily, she was in the kitchen of 10117 Beard Ave. S. when she heard something outside.

When Emily went outside to check on the noise she heard she observed both vehicles mentioned at the intersection of 101St St. W. and Beard Ave. S.

Emily checked on all parties who appeared to be "okay."

Emily said she and Lisa Marie Sanmartin had told [REDACTED] to stay until officers arrived, but he did not listen.

Unit 1 was westbound on American Blvd W crossing the intersection with Penn Ave S. Unit 1 driver thought he had a green light as he crossed the intersection.

Unit 2 was southbound on Penn Ave S crossing the intersection. Unit 2 passenger said they had the green light and also saw Unit 1 not slowing for the red light. Unit 2 passenger advised he tried to alert the driver of Unit 2 that Unit 1 was not stopping.

Unit 1 struck the driver side rear passenger door of Unit 2 causing airbag deployment on both vehicles. Chiefs towing towed both vehicles from the scene.
