On 03/15/2026 at approximately 0300 hours, I, Officer Okoi #399, was dispatched to a personal injury accident located at Old Shakopee Rd and Penn Ave S.

I then made contact with the other driver, unit 2, who stated he was working as an Uber driver. He reported that his passengers, Passenger 1 and passenger 2, were complaining of injuries.

passenger 1 stated she was experiencing neck pain and believed she had whiplash. She also stated that her daughter had struck her head and was complaining of head pain. Allina Medical and Bloomington Fire arrived on scene and escorted both passengers to the ambulance. Passenger 1 was placed in a Ccollar, and both were transported to the hospital.

unit 2 Statement

Unit stated he was driving westbound on Old Shakopee Road when he came up behind a snowplow. Due to the snowplow traveling at a slower speed and occupying more than one lane, he slowed down. After slowing, his vehicle was rearended by Iversons vehicle.

unit 2 vehicle had moderate/minor damage to the rear. Firin was able to leave the scene in his vehicle. Firin also stated that he experienced no injuries and declined medical services.

- Bicycle was northbound France Ave on the east side of the road.
- As they approached Old Shakopee Rd and attempted to change walkway signal, driver stated that she could not stop the electric bike.
- Bike accelerated into the intersection striking the side of vehicle #2.
- Vehicle #2 was eastbound on Old Shakopee Rd attempting to turn (left) north onto France Ave.
- Driver #2 stated that she was in the right turn lane to go north.
- Driver #2 stayed in the middle of the intersection until officers arrived and directed her to move.
- Damage to the passenger side of vehicle #2, but no injury to the driver.
- Witness who was westbound Old Shakopee Rd stopped at a red light confirmed #2 having a green arrow to turn and bike entered the intersection.
- Driver of bike had minor laceration injuries to left hand (3 fingers).
- Back passenger had no injuries.
- Both parties were wearing helmets, but no other safety equipment.
- Declined transportation to the hospital and parents of both arrived on scene.
- None of the parties were under the influence.
- Inexperience on the bike operator appeared to be the cause.
