Bicycle vs vehicle crash with minor injury:

Unit #1, a Bicycle was crossing 24th Avenue south on the south side of American from East to west. Unit #1 said he thought he had the right of way / ok to walk signal. Unit #1 struck Unit #2 on the left side and tipped off bike getting a scrape on his right elbow.

Unit #2 was southbound 24th crossing American Blvd in right lane. Unit #2 said she had a green light and proceeded across American and was struck by the bicycle.

Independent witness was behind unit #2 and said that he and unit #2 had a green and the bicycle crossed from the median without the right of way.

Unit #1 was checked over by Allina but refused transport.

The bicycle had no major apparent damage.

The vehicle (unit #2) had a scrape on the left side behind the rear door to the back of the left side.

On 05/23/26 at approximately 1900 hours, I, Officer Miller was dispatched to a two vehicle accident at the intersection of 81st Street and 2nd Ave, in the city of Bloomington, the county of Hennepin.

Upon my arrival, I located two vehicles in the intersection both with severe and disabling damage.

I approached everyone on scene who all stated that they were ok and did not require any medical attention.

I spoke with the driver of Unit 2 who stated to have been traveling Eastbound on 81st Street when Unit 1 struck them on the rear passenger side as they crossed through the intersection of 2nd Ave. Airbags throughout the vehicle had been deployed, and everyone was out safely.

Driver of Unit 2 stated not to have a drivers license and knew it was required to have one in order to operate a vehicle on city streets, and provided and expired insurance card.

I then went and spoke with the driver of Unit 1, who stated to have been traveling Northbound on 2nd Ave before the collision. Driver stated to have been traveling approximately 25-30 miles an hour. Driver stated to having a hard time seeing around the SUV that was parked on the corner to her left so was not able to see Unit 2 approaching the intersection.

Chief's Towing was ordered for both vehicles due to disabling damage to both vehicles.

Driver of Unit 2 was issued a citation for driving after suspension.

Due to not witnessing or having admission from Unit 1 for failure to yield, no citation was issued.

Both parties were provided the case number, advised to take pictures, and to contact their insurance companies of the accident.

Passenger 1 was informed to call the number on the card provided if transported to the hospital at a later time so it could be documented. At the time of this report, I was not informed of Passenger 1 going to the hospital.

Driver of vehicle 1 stated that he was traveling West bound on 98th street. After passing the intersection of 98th St and Pleasant driver stated he was speeding around 50 miles per hour. Stated he was in the middle lane and merged to the right lane. Stated he started to loose control and swerved into a tree on 98th Street and Garfield drive. After hitting the tree the car tipped over onto the driver side. Crash happened in-between the intersections of 98th Street/Pleasant and 98th Street/Garfield. Vehicle had a small fire and was put out by BFD.

Witness stated he saw vehicle 1 driving at a high rate of speed before swerving into the tree. Saw the vehicle turn over onto the driver side. Approached the vehicle, told the driver and passenger to kick out the sunroof to exit the vehicle.

On 05/24/26 at approximately 1656 hours, I, Officer Miller was dispatched to the intersection of American Blvd and Old Cedar Ave for a two vehicle crash. Dispatch advised the vehicles had their airbags deployed and the vehicles were blocking the intersection.

Upon my arrival I located two vehicles in the middle of American Blvd in the Eastbound lanes, just North of Old Cedar Ave.

I made contact with everyone on scene. The first person I spoke to was the driver of Unit 2 who stated to have had pain in her arms. An ambulance was ordered to the scene for assessment of her injuries.

The second person I made contact with was the driver of Unit 1 and Passenger 1. They both stated to be ok and refused medical attention. Driver of Unit 1 was emotionally upset as she spoke, and immediately stated it was her fault as she started to cry.

Unit 1 was traveling North on Old Cedar Ave approaching American Blvd, and then attempting to turn left to travel Westbound on American Blvd. It is unclear if Unit 1 fully stopped at the clearly marked stop sign or if she did not see Unit 2 as she pulled out.

As Unit 1 was attempting to turn left, she began to slow down as Unit 2 approached, causing Unit 2 to collide front into rear driver side.

Driver of Unit 2 stated to think that Unit 1 did not stop at all at the stop sign. Unit 2 stated if Unit 1 had not slowed down as it pulled out, the collision would have been avoided.

The Driver of Unit 1 had minor scratches to the left side of her neck from the seatbelt. She did not want any medical attention. Passenger 1 stated to be ok and did not want medical attention.

Driver of Unit 2 was assessed by medical paramedics with Allina and refused transport. Allina run #262888947. Driver of Unit 2 stated to think her right wrist might be broken but wanted to go home, take some pain relievers and wait a bit before deciding to go to the hospital. The registered owner of Unit 2 arrived on scene and he was advised of her condition. They were both advised to contact the Bloomington Police Department if Driver of Unit 2 does end up going to the hospital.

Information was exchanged on scene for both parties and they were informed a report would be written for insurance. Both parties were made aware of next steps for insurance and reporting the accident.
