On 05/25/26 at approximately 1707 hours, Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Old Shakopee Rd and Old Cedar Ave for a report of a two vehicle crash with injuries.

Upon Officer arrival, all occupants of both vehicles were out and on the Southside sidewalk.

I made contact with both drivers who stated they were ok.

The male driver stated he was driving Unit 1, and the female was driving Unit 2.

Unit 1 stated to have been traveling Southbound on Old Cedar Ave. Driver stated to have had the green light to turn Eastbound on Old Shakopee Rd when Unit 2 struck him on the front driver's tire in the middle of the intersection. Driver of Unit 2 stated she believed to have had the green light as she was traveling Westbound on Old Shakopee Rd, when she saw Unit 1 in the intersection and struck it head on.

Unit 2 had two passengers. Passenger 1 was sitting in the front passenger seat and sustained a small scratch to their forehead from the airbag, along with a sore chest.

Passenger 2 was sitting in the rear drivers seat, and did not sustain any injuries from the collision.

Driver of Unit 1 had minor injuries to the top of their head, and driver of Unit 2 had minor injuries to wrists. Both drivers were evaluated by paramedics and refused transport. Allina run # 052526-0488.

All parties involved were provided the case number and advised to contact their insurance with that number for claim purposes.

Photos of the accident were taken and uploaded to Axon in case they are needed.

- Both vehicles traveling eastbound on Old Shakopee Rd approaching 12th Ave.
- Passenger in vehicle #2 stated that vehicle #1 cut over from the right eastbound lane into the left eastbound lane then slowed to turn north onto 12th Ave.
- Passenger did not believe driver #1 used a blinker and warned driver #2 to stop.
- Vehicle #2 struck the rear of vehicle #1 causing damage to both vehicles.
- Driver #1 refused to provide or engage with occupants of other vehicle which forced them to call police.
- Upon arrival police found that driver #1 only has an instructional permit that is valid.
- She stated that she was trying to make a left turn when she was hit from behind.
- Driver #2 confirmed that nobody exited vehicle #1 and that the driver was the only occupant of the car.
- Driver #1 could not provide a good reason to be driving without a valid/licensed driver just stating that she has a valid license from Kenya.
- She was advised that if that was good enough, the state would have provided her a license and not just a permit.
- Driver #1 was issued a citation for the permit violation.
- Both driver's were provided the needed information.

On 05/31/2026 at approximately 1943 hours, officers were dispatched to the area of 12th Ave S and 90th St for a report of a motor vehicle accident. Dispatch advised two vehicles were involved, and there were possible injuries. Upon arrival, I located two vehicles with heavy front-end damage in the middle of the intersection. I observed a red 2021 Toyota Camry bearing Minnesota plates TUR547 with airbags deployed and damage to the front passenger side of the vehicle, and a blue 2014 Fiat 500 Series bearing Minnesota plates RAK180 with airbags deployed and damage to the front driver side of the vehicle.

I made contact with the driver and registered owner of TUR547. According to the driver, he was driving westbound on 90th St and came to a stop at the red light. He advised that he was waiting for the light to turn green to turn left onto southbound 12th Ave. Once the light turned green, He began to make the turn. He noted RAK180 was traveling at a high rate of speed southbound on 12th Ave and drove through the light and struck his car. He advised that his wife and son were in the vehicle during the crash. He advised that he had Chest and back pain, and his wife had lower back pain and had hit her knee on the dashboard. His son did not have any known injuries at this time, but wanted him to be checked out at the hospital. They were transported to Fairview Southdale by Allina (Run #262893757).

Assisting officers spoke with the driver and registered owner of RAK180, who stated the following: According to her, she was driving southbound on 12th Ave. She advised that she had a green light and proceeded through the intersection. She stated TUR547 pulled out in front of her and made a left turn from westbound 90th St to southbound 12th. She advised that this is when both vehicles collided. She advised that she had one passenger, her sister, in the vehicle during the crash. She advised that she had a bruise on her chest from the seat belt and had hit her knee on the dashboard. She was checked out by Allina medics but advised she would self-transport (Run #262893769).
