On 06/23/2026 at approximately 1722 hours, I Officer Barnum was dispatched to 86th St W. and Humboldt Ave S. for a two vehicle motor vehicle accident.

Upon arrival the two vehicles were identified as Unit 1 (ZPA783) and unit 2 (RGN581).

Around this time, I observed that Unit 1 was crashed into the metal barrier just south of 86th St W. facing south and all occupants were out of the vehicle. Unit 1's airbags were deployed and moderate damage to the front end of the vehicle was observed. It was later determined that unit 1 required a tow. Unit 2's vehicle was approximately 50 yards away in the grass off the road. Unit 2's driver was also out of the vehicle. Unit 2's vehicle had moderate damage to the front end and drivers side front quarter panel. Unit 2's vehicle also needed to be towed and airbags were deployed.

At this time, I made contact with Unit 1's driver. Unit 1's driver stated they were traveling south on Humboldt Ave when they entered the intersection of 86th St W. Upon entering the intersection, they noticed a vehicle traveling east on 86th St W. and attempted to swerve out of the way. Unit 1 stated that is why they ended up hitting the guard rail attempting to avoid the crash. Unit 1 stated they had three passengers in the vehicle however, all declined being transported by ambulance.

Unit 2's driver stated that they were traveling east on 86th St E. when they entered the intersection of Humboldt Ave S. Upon entering the intersection, he observed Unit 1 crash into the left front quarter panel of his vehicle. Due to this impact, it turned his vehicle to go south on Humboldt Ave S. Unit 2 ended up being pushed into the grass just south west of the intersection. Unit 2's driver stated they had chest pain and head pain. Unit 2's driver was transported via Allina to the hospital.

Pictures were taken of the damage to both vehicles. Both drivers were valid and had valid insurance at the time of the crash.

The weather was cloudy and it was raining hard out at the time of the crash.

No further information at this time.

3 vehicle accident. No vehicles were towed. One of the driver's (veh #2) claimed possible injury (pain to upper back and right shoulder). All driver's / passenger refused an ambulance.

The front of veh #1 struck the rear of veh #2. Veh #2 was then sent into the rear of veh #1.

Driver #1 stated: He was eastbound on W OSR in the left lane. Vehicles ahead of him were slowing down or stopping. He did look to the right where the traffic stop was taking place. He tried to stop, but could not stop in time and hit the vehicle in front of him.

Driver #1 could not give a detailed account about what had occurred.

Driver #2 stated: He was eastbound on W OSR in the left lane. The vehicles in front of him had stopped. He stopped behind those vehicles. He was then struck from behind and sent into veh #3.

Driver #3 stated: He was eastbound on W OSR in the left lane. A bus in front of him stopped for the railroad tracks. He stopped behind the bus. He was then struck from behind.

It should be noted that Officer Follen #431 and I were on a traffic stop blocking the right lane of eastbound W OSR. The accident was captured on Officer Follen's (#431) dashcam.

On 6/24/2026 at approximately 2144 hours, I observed unit #1 drive eastbound on American Blvd passing Chicago Ave. Unit #1 drove onto the median and crashed into a black and yellow street sign - then continued to drive away. I then turned my squad car around and conducted a traffic stop. While speaking to the driver of Unit #1, he informed me that he "blacked out" and stated that he urinated on himself. He did not appear to be intoxicated but it appeared to be a medical condition. Burnsville Fire Paramedics arrived on the scene and transported the driver to Fairview Southdale Hospital due to the fact that his heart readings were irregular. Paramedics suspected a heart issue caused the momentary "black out". The vehicle was not towed.

On Friday, June 26th, at approximately 11:37 hours, Bloomington police officers were dispatched to American Blvd/International Drive for a crash. Call notes indicated two cars, unknown injuries.

Upon arrival, I made contact with a blue Ford Fusion bearing Minnesota plate #TBD886. The vehicle had heavy damage to the side door, with various airbags deployed.

The driver identified herself as WINTERS, CASYIA SADE, the registered owner of the car. She told me that she was driving from International Drive, south, across American Blvd. She said she did stop for the stop sign, but wasn't sure if she stopped long enough. I learned the other vehicle was traveling westbound, and they impacted. WINTERS admitted that her vehicle was uninsured and that she did not have a license. DVS checks show her license is suspended. She was holding a 1-year-old baby, identified as passenger #2. There was also an additional passenger identified as passenger #1. All parties were transported via Allina to an unknown hospital. The vehicle was towed due to disabling damage.

Additional officers on scene made contact with vehicle #2 and its three occupants. Vehicle #2 was towed due to disabling damage. The driver's wife, Passenger #1, was transported via ALLINA to a hospital to undergo an X-ray for her arm. Unknown injury at this time.

The driver of vehicle #2, Joshua, said they were traveling westbound on American when they saw another vehicle stopped at the SB international, North of the intersection, and then pulled out in front of them, failing to yield the right of way, causing the crash.

I was issued a WINTERS citation #270126203813, failure to yield, driving after suspension, and uninsured motor vehicle.

On June 26th, 2026 at approximately 17:27, I, Officer Matt Jones, Badge 339, was dispatched to a personal injury collision at 200 American Boulevard West. Upon arrival, I observed multiple damaged vehicles stopped in the middle of American Boulevard. It should be noted that it was daylight out with partly cloudy skies and the roadways were dry.

The first vehicle (Unit One), a white 2016 Toyota Camry bearing Minnesota license plate SMW147, had heavy front end damage and was stopped in the middle of the westbound lanes on American Boulevard. The registered owner and driver was Kaltumo Muhumed Habaruwa, date of birth April 28, 1978. Habaruwa had a swollen right arm which she thought was broken. I located an expired Progressive insurance card in the vehicle dated from the previous year. A family member confirmed Habaruwa still had Progressive insurance with the same policy number. The airbags were deployed on the Camry.

The second vehicle was a brown Honda CR-V (Unit Two) bearing Minnesota license plate KGH881. The vehicle had heavy front end damage and was facing westbound in the eastbound lanes of traffic. The driver was Rahma Mohamed Abdullahi, date of birth September 1, 2006. Abdullahi stated she had abdominal and lower extremity pain. The airbags were deployed on the brown Honda CR-V.

The third vehicle was a blue Honda CR-V (Unit Three) bearing Minnesota license plate RTG349. The vehicle was facing eastbound in the left turn lane to turn north into the Sam's Club parking lot. The driver was Bakary Konate, date of birth December 15, 1993. Konate stated he had no injuries. The brown Honda CR-V had struck the front of the blue Honda CR-V.

The fourth vehicle was a silver Dodge Journey (Unit Four) bearing Minnesota license plate 5DH730. The vehicle was facing eastbound behind the blue Honda CR-V and had minimal front end damage. The driver was Shanquita Cherrelle Pruitt, date of birth June 22, 1986. Pruitt stated she had head and neck pain. Pruitt confirmed she needed an ambulance for her injuries.

I requested ambulances for the injured parties. Allina Ambulance transported Habaruwa, Abdullahi, and Pruitt to the hospital (Fairview Southdale) under run number 262911408.

After speaking with all parties involved and several witnesses on scene, I learned the following collision sequence. The white Toyota Camry drove southbound out of the Sam's Club parking lot in an attempt to go eastbound on American Boulevard. The brown Honda CR-V was traveling westbound on American Boulevard when it struck the white Toyota Camry. The brown Honda CR-V then collided with the blue Honda CR-V which was stopped in the eastbound left turn lane (to Sam's Club). The rear of the blue Honda CR-V then struck the front of the silver Dodge Journey.

A passenger in the white Toyota Camry stated they were waiting to exit the parking lot when the roadway appeared clear. She indicated the brown Honda CR-V was traveling at a high speed. Multiple witnesses confirmed the brown Honda CR-V was traveling westbound when the white Toyota Camry failed to yield while exiting the parking lot.

Based on the statements given by all the other drivers and witnesses on scene, Kaltumo Habaruwa failed to yield to traffic on American Boulevard. I issued Habaruwa a citation (270126203822) for failing to yield to vehicles traveling on the roadway.

The white Toyota Camry and brown Honda CR-V were towed to Chief's Towing located at 86th and Harriet in Bloomington due to heavy damage and inoperability. The blue Honda CR-V was driven from the scene by Konate. The silver Dodge Journey sustained minimal damage but was towed by Chief's due to the driver, Pruitt, being transported to the hospital.

I provided police report cards to the involved parties with case number information for insurance purposes.
