VEH 1 WAS DRIVING WB ON 86TH TOWARDS XERXES AV S WHEN PEDESTRIAN CROSSED THE MARKED INTERSECTION SOUTHBOUND ON XERXES CROSSING 86TH ST W. THE INTERSECTION WAS CONTROLLED BY TWO CLEARLY MARKED STOP SIGNS FOR EAST AND WESTBOUND TRAFFIC. DRIVER OF VEH 1 ADMITTED THAT HE HAD DROPPED AN ITEM AND WAS REACHING DOWN TO GRAB IT WHEN HE DID NOT SEE THE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING THE INTERSECTION. DRIVER ALSO ADMITTED TO NOT COMING TO A FULL STOP AT THE STOP SIGN AND AS A RESULT OF BEING DISTRACTED HE COLLIDED INTO THE PEDESTRIAN AS THEY WERE MID INTERSECTION. THE PEDESTRIAN ADVISED THAT SHE RECALLED SEEING VEH 1 COMING W/B ON 86TH ST TOWARDS XERXES AND WAS STRUCK BY IT. PEDESTRIAN ADVISED SHE HAD HIT HER HEAD ON THE GROUND AFTER THE COLLISION AND SHE HAD A MODERATE AMOUNT OF BLOOD ON HER HEAD AND FACE, AS WELL AS A LARGE GASH ON THE TOP RIGHT SIDE OF HER HEAD.

THE PEDESTRIAN WAS TRANSPORTED BY ALLINA TO THE HOSPITAL FOR FURTHER CARE. THE DRIVER OF VEH 1 ADVISED THAT HE BELIEVES HE WAS DRIVING AROUND 15-20 MPH DURING THE COLLISION. THERE WAS MODERATE BUT FUNCTIONAL DAMAGE TO THE FRONT LEFT SIDE OF HIS FRONT BUMPER. THE DAMAGE APPEARED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH A SPEED THAT WAS POSSIBLY HIGHER THAN 20 MPH COLLISION.

OFCS ALSO SPOKE TO A WITNESS ON SCENE WHO ADVISED THEY HEARD A VERY LOUD COLLISION AT THE INTERSECTION, FOLLOWED BY A LOUD SCREECHING AND SQUEALING SOUND COMING FROM VEH 1. THE WITNESS ADVISED THAT VEH 1 WAS DRIVING FAST AND HAD DROVE NORTH BRIEFLY ON XERXES AFTER THE COLLISION BEFORE U-TURNING AND TURNING E/B ONTO 86TH ST W. THE WITNESS ADVISED THAT HE DROVE HIS VEHICLE OUT IN FRONT OF VEH 1 TO PREVENT HIM FROM LEAVING. THE WITNESS DID NOT KNOW IF THE DRIVER OF VEH 1 WAS INTENDING TO COMMIT A HIT AND RUN WHEN ASKED.

THE DRIVER OF VEH 1 WAS CITED FOR FAILING TO STOP AT A STOP SIGN. PHOTOS WERE TAKEN OF THE DAMAGE TO VEH 1 AND UPLOADED TO AXON. BOTH DRIVERS WERE GIVEN THE CASE NUMBER FOR THE STATE CRASH REPORT.

Unit 1 was traveling east on 86th St, approaching Wentworth Ave S. Unit 1 passed Unit 2, who was signaling to turn east onto 86th St from Harriet Ave S. Unit 1 then stopped behind traffic stop at the stoplight 86th St/Nicollet Ave S. Unit 1 saw Unit 2 approaching quickly from behind, Unit 2 then hit the back right bumper on Unit 1. Unit 1 was pushed into opposing traffic, Unit 2 stopped to the right of Unit 1. The driver of unit 1 believed the driver of unit 2 was intoxicated because his face was red/flushed and his eyes were watery. Both units pulled over to the right side of the road and called police for assistance. Unit 2 was arrested for driving under the influence. At the time of this report Unit 2 driver had not completed the DMT test yet.

On 6/12/2026 at approximately 1128 hours, Officers observed 2 vehicles that appeared to be in a collision at 86th St. and Lyndale Ave. Speaking to the driver of Unit #1, they stated that they were driving westbound on 86th St. When they approached the intersection, they stated that they had a green light, but not a protected arrow green light. The vehicle then turn southbound onto Lyndale Ave. That is when Unit #1 collided with Unit #2, as unit #2 was traveling eastbound on 86th St. Unit #2 stated the same thing. Witness #1 stated that they observed Unit #1 turning southbound onto Lyndale Ave on the green light and collide into Unit #2 as it was driving eastbound. Neither party needed medical attention. Unit #2 was towed by Chiefs Towing and Unit #1 was able to drive to their house.
