Two car accident. Hit and Run. No cars were towed. Both drivers stated they were not injured.

The front of veh #1 struck the rear of veh #2.

Driver #2 stated: He was southbound on Penn Ave S in the left, straight lane. He stopped at a red light. The red light was near Penn Ave S and 494. It was just north of 494 or just south of it. He was the third or second vehicle in line. He was struck from behind by veh #1. He got out and talked to Driver #1. Driver #1 advised he had no insurance. He went to get his insurance and Driver #1 had left in veh #1.

I was able to make contact with the Driver of veh #1 at his house.

Driver #1 stated: He was southbound on Penn Ave S in the left, straight lane. He attempted to stop, but could not stop in time and hit the rear of veh #2. He thinks it happened just south of 494. He made contact with driver #2. He told Driver #2 that he did not have insurance.

Driver #2 was cited with hit and run and no insurance.

Both driver's were unsure of exactly where the accident took place on Penn Ave S.

Unit 1 traveling Southbound on Portland Ave, turning Eastbound onto American Blvd. Driver of unit 1 stated she had a green light to turn eastbound onto American Blvd. Crashed into unit 2 at the intersection of Portland Ave and American Blvd.

Unit 2 traveling Northbound on Portland Ave, crossing American Blvd struck by unit 1. Unit 2 stated he had a green light to cross American Blvd. Front right passenger of unit 2 saw unit 1 not yield. Back left passenger of unit 2 saw unit 1 not yield as well. Unit 2 occupied with four passengers.

Witness driving behind unit 2 traveling Northbound on Portland Ave saw unit 1 crash into unit 2. Stated unit 2 had the green light.

Unit 1 front driver side struck front driver side of unit 2. Unit 1 had severe damage to entire front bumper.

Unit 2 had significant damage to front driver's side bumper/quarter panel.

Driver of Unit 1 checked out by Allina not transported.

Driver and back left passenger of unit checked out by Allina. Passenger transported by Allina.

On 7/4/2026 at approximately 1522 hours, Officers were dispatched to France Ave and 102nd St. for a personal injury vehicle accident. Officers arrived and I observed the driver of Unit #1 on the ground wearing a full face motorcycle helmet, unresponsive, and appearing to be agonal breathing. Witness #1 informed me that the driver of Unit #1 was riding his motorcycle and flipped over his handlebars when he attempted to stop his motorcycle. I spoke with the driver and passenger of Unit #2, who stated that they were driving northbound on France Ave, they approached the traffic light at 102nd St. when they approached the light, they attempted to turn west on 102nd St. Unit #1 was driving northbound on France Ave behind Unit #2. When Unit #2 was clear to turn westbound, they began turning westbound. Unit #1 then attempted to pass Unit #2 on the drivers side of the vehicle, as Unit #2 was turning westbound. Unit #1 then attempted to stop his motorcycle and the driver of Unit #2 stated that he collided with the drivers side of Unit #2. The driver of Unit #1 then flipped over the handlebars and landed on the pavement. Due to the fact that the driver of Unit #1 appeared to be agonal breathing and unresponsive, he was transported to HCMC by Allina paramedics. (070426-0377) His motorcycle was towed by Chiefs towing and transported to the Bloomington Police Department. The drivers of Unit #2 declined medical attention, nor did they need their vehicle towed.

It should be noted that the driver of unit #1 had a firearm on his person, for safety of the paramedics and Officers, the firearm was removed from the driver of Unit #1 and brought to the Bloomington Police Department where it was placed in a temporary evidence locker for safekeeping, along with a few other personal belongings. It should be noted that the driver did not have an active permit to carry a firearm.

Speaking with Witness #2, they appeared to share the same story that the driver of Unit #2 stated. Adding to the fact that it appeared that Unit #1 appeared to partially cross over the yellow dividing line, attempted to brake with the front brakes, then appeared to flip over the handle bars. Witness #2 stated that they were uncertain if Unit #1 made contact with Unit #2.

Bloomington Police Traffic Investigation arrived on scene shortly after the crash and processed the scene.
