Vehicle 1 (MN License LYG611), driven by Nasro Ibrahim (per witnesses and the e-bike rider), was positioned in the center turn lane on eastbound 86th Street. Unit 2 was traveling eastbound in the adjacent bike lane. Vehicle 1 made an abrupt right turn from the center turn lane (incorrect lane for the maneuver), crossed the eastbound travel lane, and struck Unit 2. The collision caused injury to Unit 2s elbow and damage to his e-bike. The driver of Vehicle 1 denied making an improper turn. Vehicle 1 sustained damage to the front passenger-side fender. Vehicle 1 was determined to be at fault, and the driver was issued a citation.

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Unit 1 was traveling East bound on Old Shakopee RD at the intersection of Hampshire. Driver of unit 1 stated he saw the light was turning yellow then red. Unit 1 driver stated he increased his speed to try to beat the red light. Unit 1 driver stated all other traffic East bound had stopped at light.

Unit 2 was traveling West bound on Old Shakopee RD at the intersection of Hampshire. Driver of unit 2 turned south bound on Hampshire with a flashing yellow light. Unit 2 struck unit 1 head on as unit 2 turned south bound onto Hampshire. Unit 2 driver stated he had a flashing yellow light and all traffic was stopped at time of turn.

Unit 2 driver stated unit 1 immediately got out of vehicle and stated it was his fault. Unit 1 driver confirmed it was his fault to Officers on scene.

Unit 3 was at the intersection of Old Shakopee and Hampshire traveling North bound. Unit 3 was stopped at a red light. Unit 1 crashed into unit 3 from the force of unit 2. Unit 3 driver was not moving at time of incident.
