Neighborhood Open House for Knox Avenue Intersection Study

During the summer of 2019 the city conducted a temporary traffic circle trial at the intersection of W 83rd Street and Knox Avenue to try to solve intersection safety concerns. While the traffic circle was in place staff collected traffic data to determine how the circle affected vehicles going through this intersection. Staff also conducted an opinion survey via direct mail about the traffic circle and its effects on the intersection.

The purpose of the meeting on Tuesday January 14th, 2020 is to review the data collected and results of the opinion survey. Staff will also go over the next steps to move this project forward.

Based on data collected and opinion survey, staff is recommending a permanent traffic circle be installed at this intersection to improve traffic safety.

No changes will be made to the traffic signal at Knox Avenue and W 82nd Street with this project.
