ANIMAL TRACK BINGO CALLER'S CARD

About Animal Track BINGO

On the frontier, the best time of year to hunt and trap was winter when animal tracks could be seen in the snow.

In this activity, play BINGO and learn the tracks of 10 different Minnesota animals.

Print enough BINGO cards for all the players, and enough BINGO Player Keys for everyone to see. Then print this Bingo Caller's Card.

Instead of BINGO, the Dakota word "Ohiya", which means "to win", appears at the top.

Caller's Instructions

- Randomly choose one of the letters in OHIYA and an animal name.
- Announce it to the players
- Check it off on the Caller's Card.
- Wait a moment for players to check to see if they have that animal's tracks under that letter on their card.
- If players do have that letter and animal combination, instruct them to mark the spot with a penny, button or other small object.
- The center spot on the BINGO cards is a "free space".
- The first player to get five tracks in a row, vertically, horizontally, or diagonally shouts "Ohiya!" (pronounced o-hee-yah) and wins the game.
- Prizes can also increase the fun.
