HISTORY AND SCOPE

IN 2014, THE CITY'S ENGINEERING DIVISION APPLIED FOR A REGIONAL SOLICITATION GRANT FROM THE METROPOLITAN COUNCIL IN AN EFFORT TO IMPROVE PEDESTRIAN AND BIKEWAY FACILITIES ALONG EAST BLOOMINGTON FREEWAY (EBF) AND W. 106TH STREET. THE APPLICATION CITED SAFETY CONCERNS DUE TO THE PROXIMITY OF TRUNK HIGHWAY I-35W, AS WELL AS IMPROVING CONNECTIONS TO SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AND THE LYNDALE AVENUE RETAIL NODE. THE APPLICATION WOULD EVENTUALLY BE APPROVED FOR CONSTRUCTION IN THE 2019-2020 TIME FRAME.

WITH THIS PROJECT, THE CITY ALSO PLANS COMPLETE THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE EBF ROAD PAVEMENT FROM W. 106TH STREET TO W. 99TH STREET AND CONSTRUCT CONCRETE CURB AND GUTTER ON BOTH SIDES OF EBF. CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROAD WOULD BE COMPLETED THROUGH THE CITY'S PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (PMP).
