- 2. Hotels with laundry service shall insure equipment is maintained in working order and vents are cleaned on a regular basis.
- 3. Employee training on fire safety and the evacuation plan shall be conducted for all new employees and periodically for all employees thereafter.
- 4. All employees shall participate in evacuation drills at least quarterly on each shift.
