Three Adults Treated For Possible Drug Overdose

Last night at 8:18 pm, Bloomington Police responded to an unconscious male, (34 years old from Minneapolis) in the South Food Court at the Mall of America. As Police and Allina Medics attempted to resuscitate him, a female, (35 years old from Minneapolis) who was with the male also began losing consciousness and also required medical attention. During the course of their treatment it was determined that they were possibly overdosing on a narcotic. Both regained consciousness on scene and were transported to Fairview Southdale Hospital.

Shortly after, at 8:37 pm, a Trooper with the Minnesota State Patrol had a vehicle stopped on the southeast side of the MOA. He requested Allina and assistance from Bloomington Police. A subject inside that car was also treated for a possible narcotic overdose. It was determined that all three had been together prior to their medical emergencies. State Patrol was primary on that incident.

The Bloomington Police are aware of the recent drug overdoses in Anoka County and at this time cannot confirm if they are related. Further investigation will continue.
