GENERAL LEAGUE INFORMATION

The Bloomington Parks and Recreation offers a variety of adult athletic leagues throughout the 2016 winter months which include Women's and Co-Rec Volleyball, Dodgeball, and 3-on-3 Basketball leagues. Volleyball matches are played at Kennedy Activity Center and Bloomington Armory, Dodgeball games are played at Richfield STEM School, and 3-on-3 Basketball games are played at Richfield Middle School. 2016 Winter Volleyball Leagues

Leagues begin Monday, January 4th and play a 10 match season. Each match consists of 3 games played to 25 points using the rally scoring system. All matches have a 1 hour time limit. A variety of competition levels are offered to allow participants to choose the level of competition that best suits their team.
