





The Cities of Bloomington, Edina and Richfield are committed to making their communities welcoming to all types of transportation . . .

Edina

- **Developed the Pedestrian and Cyclist Safety Fund:** This fund supports projects that make the community more walkable and bikeable.
- **Adopted a Living Streets Policy and Plan:** These focus on a street network that accommodates all users and all modes.
- **Initiated a bike parking cost share program:** The program helps to increase bicycle parking throughout the City.
- **Designated bronze level Bicycle-Friendly Community.**

The three cities are partnering with Bloomington's Division of Public Health, local bike advocate groups and the Joint Community Police Partnership to promote biking and walking for healthy lifestyles. Here's what they're doing.

Richfield

- **Designated bronze level Bicycle-Friendly Community.**
- **Richfield Bicycle Advocates:** This resident-led group supports education, advocacy and community action to increase the viability of walking & biking in Richfield. For more information, visit <http://bikerichfield.org>
- **Additional bike facilities and bike parking cost share program:** Ten miles of bicycle facilities are programmed for completion by 2018, and bike parking in Richfield is increased.
- **Richfield Police distribute bike safety information.**

Bloomington

- **Updating Alternative Transportation Plan:** Plan outlines steps to improve infrastructure, facilities and education to increase bicycling and walking.
- **The Bloomington Bicycle Alliance:** This is a bicycle advocacy group of citizens who are working to promote and increase bicycle ridership. <https://www.facebook.com/BloomingtonBicycleAlliance>
- **Increasing bike and pedestrian infrastructure:** Adding off-road, multi-use trails in 2015-16 on the Hyland and InterCity trails and on Normandale Blvd. between 94th St. and Nine Mile Creek.
- **Received an Honorable Mention on its first Bicycle-Friendly Community application.**
