

Cell Phone Lifeline Program

Human Services is partnering with Life Wireless to provide eligible individuals with a free cell phone without a contract or activation fee.

Creekside Community Center:**

Wednesday, March 18, 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.

Saturday, April 18, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Wednesday, April 22, 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.



To qualify for the program, individuals must either meet income guidelines or participate in an assistance program. Individuals can also income qualify with 6 most recent pay stubs or a copy of last year's tax return.

If an individual meets the qualifications, a free cell phone, with no contract or activation fee will be issued. Individuals will receive 250 minutes a month or 750 text messages. If an individual uses this amount before the month is over, the cell phone will automatically turn off until the next month begins. Individuals have the option to purchase additional minutes for as low as \$5 per month at any Money Gram location.
