The Engineering Division invites you to an open house meeting to discuss the 2015-901 Storm Sewer Maintenance Project. We encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to gather information on the project. Please park in the visitor parking lot on the west side of the building near the intersection of 98th & Logan. Use the south entrance for the 2 p.m. meeting, and the west entrance for the 5:30 p.m. meeting.

What's being proposed?

This project involves maintenance work to the City storm sewer system at 23 sites. Work activity varies, from small pipe or manhole repairs, to more invasive excavation, pipe replacement and temporary road closures. See the list and map on the enclosed sheet for the sites and proposed work. The Project is tentatively scheduled for construction to start in late June 2014 and be completed in the fall. Where construction will be disruptive, residents will receive another notice prior to construction. Work is funded by the Storm Drainage Utility with no assessments.

What happens at the meeting(s)?

The meeting will be an open house format consisting of poster sheets showing various aspects of the proposed construction. You will have the opportunity to speak with Engineering Division staff and ask questions you may have about the project. There will be no formal presentation.
