

RESOLUTION NO. 2014- 107

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE 60-DAY NEGOTIATION PERIOD BETWEEN THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON AND LICENSED RESIDENTIAL COLLECTORS AS PER MINNESOTA STATUTE 115A.94 ORGANIZED COLLECTION

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Bloomington, Minnesota is the official governing body of the City of Bloomington; and

WHEREAS on July 28, 2014 the Bloomington City Council directed City staff to proceed with the planning process to establish an organized solid waste collection system as per Minnesota Statute 115A.94; and

WHEREAS Minnesota Statute 115A.94 subd. 4d Participating Collectors Proposal Requirement requires the City Bloomington to provide a 60-day period in which meetings or negotiations shall occur exclusively between licensed collectors and the City of Bloomington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City has designated October 14, 2014 as the official date to begin the required 60-day period of exclusive negotiations between licensed collectors and the City;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council has approved the Bloomington Priorities and Parameters that will be used during the negotiations with the existing licensed residential collectors; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Bloomington authorizes City staff to work with the existing licensed residential collectors as per the requirements of Minnesota Statute 115A.94 subd. 4d; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City shall negotiate in good faith with the existing licensed residential collectors as per the Statute toward a mutually agreed upon proposal for consideration of the City Council of the City of Bloomington.

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
