2015 League Information

Registration for the 2015 Fall Adult Sports Leagues will be open Monday, June 29— July 20 for **returning teams** who participated in a 2014 Bloomington Fall League. New team registration begins Wednesday, July 22.

Play begins August 24th. Softball leagues play five weeks of double headers, Kickball leagues play a 6 week season and touch football leagues play a seven week season. Play is offered from competitive to recreational levels.

All games will be officiated. One umpire for softball and kickball. Three officials for touch football. Teams are required to provide equipment for their usage. For Softball this includes gloves, bats, and balls. As a part of registration, all teams will be provided one (1) dozen new softballs by the City.

Notice: Teams will receive one (1) dozen game balls as part of registration, see pg. 2 for game ball details.

Touch football teams are required to have each player in uniform. Similar colored shirts are sufficient for a uniform.

Each touch football team is required to supply their own game ball which meets National Federation specifications.



July 2015

Fees include a ten game season, which includes scheduling of a field, umpires and t-shirts for the league champions.

Teams are considered to be non-resident if the team is not comprised of at least 75% of team members living or working in Bloomington.

Touch Football \$535 + tax = \$573.92

Non Resident League Fees Fall Softball \$550 + tax = \$590.01

Touch Football \$560+ tax = \$600.74



To accommodate double headers in the short fall season, all softball leagues must have an even number of teams. Registrations may be returned to the last team that registers for a league if their registration creates an odd amount of teams in the league.

2015 League Offerings

Gold Leagues: Competitive leagues intended for teams seeking a highly competitive league experience, and who participate in multiple tournaments throughout the season

Silver Leagues: Recreational leagues intended for teams who do not participate in tournaments throughout the season, but desire a moderately competitive league experience

Bronze Leagues: A recreational experience with a low level of competition

Softballs: The game ball that is used does not need to be a new ball, but it must be verified that it is a legal ball. Legal balls for the 2015 season are to be optic yellow in color and: Male batter -12 inch red stitched ball with a COR of .52 and a maximum compression of 300 lbs. Female batter -11 inch red stitched ball with a COR of .44 and a maximum compression of 375 lbs

2015 Touch Football League

The City of Bloomington offers adult League Rules touch football leagues. All teams will be registered with the Minnesota **Sports Federation.** Leagues are played at Dred Scott Playfield. All games are officiated by three officials. Bloomington has the luxury of having the MSF's Touch Football 2. Rules Interpreter work as the lead official for the touch football leagues.

Wednesday - Star B/C

The Wednesday B/C league is geared towards B teams and competitive C teams that have participated at MSF State Tournaments.



1. Passing — One forward pass per down. A forward pass is a pass that crosses the line of scrimmage. Unlimited passes may be made behind the line of scrimmage,

of scrimmage.

Blocking/Rushing — Player blocking must remain on his feet. Arms must be extended, but no further than 45 degrees at the point contact is initiated. The hands must remain open. Contact must not be made above the shoulders, in the back or below the waist. Players must not attempt to play through their opponent.

- 3. Touching - Placing one hand on or below the shoulders of an opponent (including the ball). Diving tags are not legal, one foot of the toucher must be on the ground when the tag is made.
- 4. Snapping the Ball — The ball must pass through the center's legs to be considered a legal snap.

GAME INORMATION

Games are played on fields that are 90 yards from end line to end line and 40 yards wide. Field markings include 15 and 35 yard lines that also serve as first down markers.

Games are scheduled to start at 6:00, 6:55, 7:50, 8:45 and 9:40, If a team does not have six eligible players at game time, the game clock will start. If, after 5 minutes, the team does not have six players, the game will be declared a forfeit.

All Games are played in two, 20 minute halves.

How to Register:

Online: Use our online league registration system. Returning teams who participated in a league the previous year may register online during the returning team registration period June 29-July 20. This allows teams to register for only the same league and night they participated in the previous year.

IMPORTANT

A representative from your team is strongly encouraged to attend the Managers' Meeting to receive your team's pertinent league information (schedules, rule books, etc). The meeting will be held the week of August 10th at the Bloomington Civic Plaza.

Completed City roster/waiver form must be turned in prior to your team's first game. Failure to do so will result in your team being penalized with forfeits until a completed form is submitted. After three weeks of play forfeits will become official if your roster/waiver form has not been received. All players participating on your team must be on your team's roster form. If they are not listed on your team's roster, they are considered an ineligible player and your team is risking forfeits.

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Terms and Conditions

1. By registering for this Parks and Recreation activity, you are responsible for all fees associated with registration.

2. All fees associated with registration must accompany your registration form, or registration will not be processed.

3. All teams will provide Parks & Recreation with a completed roster form prior to the first game.

4. All teams registered for a Bloomington Adult Sports League are subject to a mandatory transfer at the discretion of the League Director. A mandated transfer by the League Director may occur, but is not limited to, the level of competition, previous league results, number of teams per league, or team classification. Teams subject to a mandatory transfer may withdraw their team's registration and make their request to the League Director within 48 hours of being notified of their transfer to receive a refund of their registration fees. After 48 hours has expired, all refunds will be subject to the Cancellation/Withdrawal Policy.

- 5. Cancellation/Withdrawal Policy
- **Full refunds will be processed if** the league your team is registered for is cancelled by Parks and Recreation due to lack of teams.
- **Pro-rated refunds will be processed if** scheduled games are cancelled and make up dates are not available due to unavailable facilities.
- **Teams will receive a full refund less a \$50 service charge if** your team withdraws at least 3 weeks before the start of play.
- **Refunds will not be processed if** your team withdraws less than 3 weeks before the start of play or if your team is removed from the league due to disciplinary action.

6. Data Privacy Act/Tennessen Warning

According to the Minnesota Data Privacy Act, some of the information you provide on this form may be classified as private data. Private data is available to you but not the public. If you do not provide this data, you are not eligible to play in the City of Bloomington Adult Athletic Leagues. By signing below, you are consenting to allow registration information to be shared with the Minnesota Sports Federation Staff, Minnesota Recreation and Parks Association Staff, City of Bloomington Supervisors, officials, and other registered program participants for the purpose of administering the above listed recreational program.
