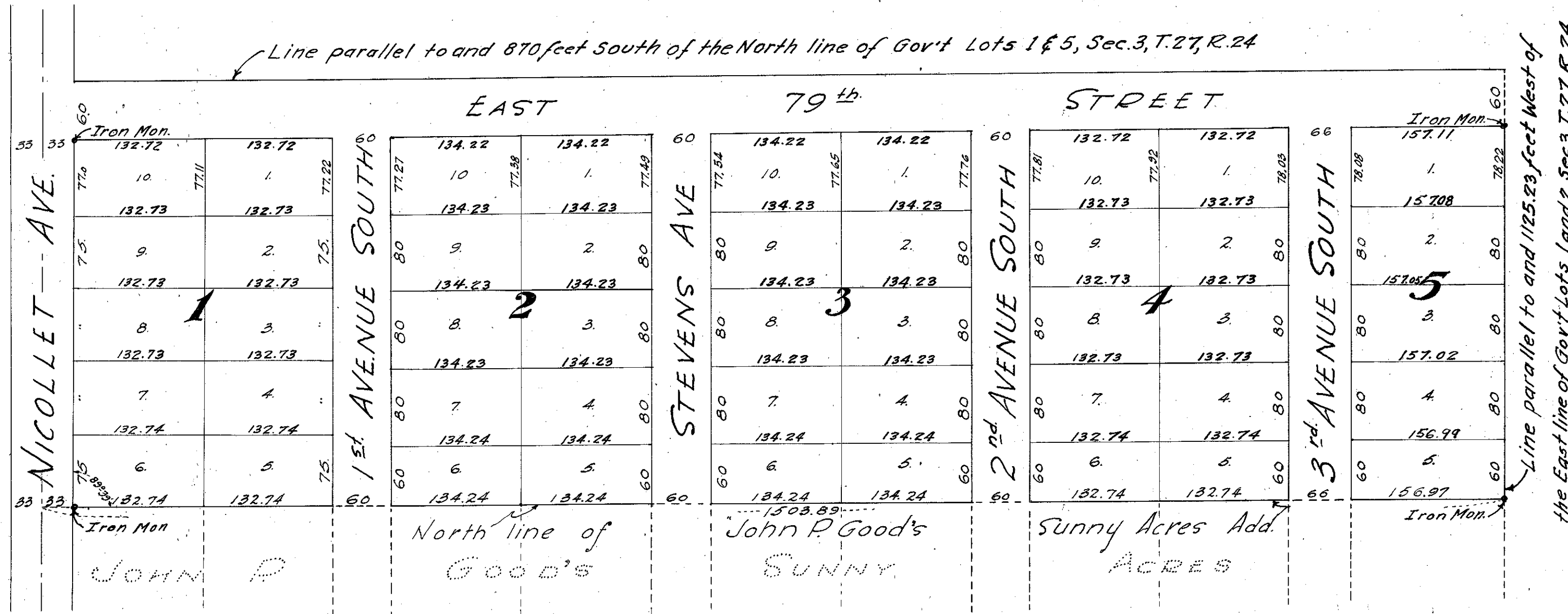


FENLASON'S FIRST ADDITION

Good's Sunny Acres, South of a line drawn parallel to and 870 feet South of the North line of said Government Lots One (1) and Five (5) and West of a line parallel to and 1125.23 feet West of the East line of said Government Lots One (1) and Two (2). Have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as "FENLASON'S FIRST ADDITION" and do hereby donate and dedicate to the public for public use forever the streets and Avenues as shown on the annexed plat.
